This investigation of case #A2018-027 involving Sr. Deputy Kenny Lewis #1187 and Mr. [REDACTED] is submitted for closure.

**Synopsis:** On 03/28/18, IAU received an email from Captain Tilton regarding a use of force incident involving Sr. Dep. Lewis, resulting in an injury to Mr. [REDACTED] arm.

Sr. Dep. Lewis wrote an Incident Report (#180215581) documenting his use of force on Mr. [REDACTED]. Sr. Dep. Lewis wrote that on 03/21/18, he was dispatched to ZSFGH Building #25 (H4212) to assist hospital staff in controlling Mr. [REDACTED], an aggressive, combative hospital patient, so that medical staff could administer medication to him. Mr. [REDACTED] was throwing objects toward nursing staff, including urine container. When Sr. Dep. Lewis grabbed Mr. [REDACTED]'s left wrist to control him, he resisted by violently pulling away from Sr. Dep. Lewis. Mr. [REDACTED] kicked and punched Sr. Dep. Lewis during the struggle. Nursing staff was eventually able to control Mr. [REDACTED]'s legs while Sr. Dep. Lewis controlled the rest of his body by placing his left hand on Mr. [REDACTED] chest. Mr. [REDACTED] received medication by injection. Mr. [REDACTED] complained that his arm was injured. Sr. Dep. Lewis immediately referred him to medical staff. Mr. [REDACTED] received medical assessment/treatment at ZSFGH.

Mr. [REDACTED] was discharged from ZSFGH before IAU could interview him. Mr. [REDACTED] was listed as homeless, with no contact information. [REDACTED] who was present during the incident, did not respond to our requests for interview. The IAU obtained surveillance video depicting Sr. Dep. Lewis responding to the location. However, there are no surveillance cameras in hospital rooms.

On Wednesday, March 21, 2018, I was on duty in uniform assigned to 1V03 for the San Francisco Sheriff's Patrol Unit (SPU). At approximately 1800 hours, I was dispatched to Building #25 (H4212), regarding an aggressive patient.

Upon arrival I made contact with [REDACTED] told me patient [REDACTED] threw food, plastic trays and fluid at medical staff. [REDACTED] also said [REDACTED] was aggressive and combative towards her and other medical staff. Before entering the room, I saw food and fluid on the hallway floor leading into H4212. I walked over to the nursing station to ask what they were going to do. Medical staff advised me they wanted to give [REDACTED] oral medication. As I walked back to H4212, from the hallway looking into the room, I saw [REDACTED] throw a plastic urine container towards medical staff.

I entered the room and saw food and fluid all over the floor and an empty plastic food tray by the sink and one empty plastic food tray on the floor by the foot of [REDACTED] bed. Medical staff entered the room and said they were going to give [REDACTED] a shot of medication. Medical staff asked me to standby while medication was administered. I walked to the left side of the bed and stood next to [REDACTED] left shoulder. He was laying on his back. When he was told he was going to receive a shot, [REDACTED] yelled, "You are not going to give me a shot!" [REDACTED] turned his body to the left and kicked at me with both of his feet. One of his feet made contact with my lower torso.

Medical staff grabbed [REDACTED] legs and attempted to hold them down. As I tried to move away from [REDACTED] legs, he punched my left elbow with his right hand. I grabbed his left wrist and attempted to control his hand. He violently moved his body from side to side and tried to pull his hand away from me. I placed my left hand on his chest and attempted to prevent him from moving. Medical staff continued to try and secure [REDACTED] legs. He did not stop resisting. Before I had a chance to let go of [REDACTED] medical staff grabbed his right arm, held it down, and gave him a shot. Someone said "that's the only shot we are giving him". I immediately let go of [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] complained his arm hurt. I was concerned [REDACTED] may have injured himself while resisting and advised medical staff.

Since [REDACTED] was an admitted medical patient, in the interest of justice, I opted to not charge him with assault on a peace officer.

A Senior Deputy responded to ZSFGH Building 25, 4th floor on the report of an aggressive patient. SD arrived and found patient was throwing items, including a urine container at staff. Staff attempted to give the patient a shot and were attempting to hold the patient down. The patient kicked the SD in the torso and punched him in the left elbow. The SD maintained a control hold as the medical staff also held and administered the shot, as the patient was violently throwing himself side to side. Nurses in the room reported hearing a pop. The SD stated in his report that the patient said his arm hurt and urged staff to examine it.
