There has been a **possible** exposure to COVID-19 at Johnson Road and the building is closed until further notice. All Johnson Road staff should contact their health professional regarding testing. According to CDC guidelines:

The CDC defines "close contact" as:

- ✓ a person that has been within six feet of an infected person for a prolonged period of time (15 minutes or more)
- ✓ a person who provided care at home to someone who is sick with COVID-19
- ✓ a person who had direct physical contact with a person (hugged or kissed them)
- ✓ a person who shared eating or drinking utensils
- ✓ a person who got droplets from someone who sneezed, coughed, or spread some other respiratory type droplets

To be as cautious as possible I am suggesting that everyone who works at Johnson Road be tested, and at the very least contact your health professional for more guidance. *For your information only:* we are hoping to reopen Johnson Road December 7th, but that is not a guarantee and will not be publicized until we have a more definitive answer. More information will be forthcoming.
