Most of the managers met with me today (via Zoom) to discuss our immediate plans.

- Both Library buildings closed to public visits at approximately 3:30 yesterday afternoon.
- Johnson Road staff and non-public services staff at Delmar Avenue worked their regular schedules yesterday and today.
- Public Services staff at Delmar Avenue were sent home yesterday afternoon and are being called back to work tomorrow, Thursday, November 19th.
- By tomorrow, all staff will again be working their regular hours.
- Staff who have scheduled paid leave may take their paid time off as scheduled.
- Johnson Road returned to curbside service yesterday afternoon.
- Details are being worked out for us to provide curbside service at Delmar Avenue.
- Details are also being developed for us to provide limited in-person by-appointment-only visits at both buildings. At Johnson Road, there will be a limit of 1 customer in the building at a time for one half-hour by-appointment-only visit per day. At Delmar Avenue, there will be a limit of 3 people in adult services and 1 person in youth services at a time, again for one half-hour by-appointment-only visit per day.
- Our goal is for all limited services to begin to be available Monday, November 23rd, during our regularly scheduled weekly hours (other than scheduled holiday closures).
- Announcements are being developed to share via our website, social media, and other outlets.
- We don't know how long the buildings will be closed to these limited services only.
- Everything is subject to change.

I truly appreciate your care and support for the library and our community. Your adaptability and resilience during these challenging times make a huge difference in the library's ability to be responsive to our community while taking extensive precautions to maintain as safe an environment as possible.
