Well, friends, it has been a rip-roaring ride these past few days getting library services rearranged to meet our goal:

**To provide as much service as possible while maintaining the highest degree of safety doing that.**

We have been providing curbside service at Johnson Road for several months. We are now ready to begin curbside service at Delmar Avenue as well. I did talk with Rebecca today, and should customers start calling to get their holds Saturday, we are ready to accommodate that.

Starting Monday, 11/23, in-person by-appointment-only visits will be available to the public. These visits are limited to one half-hour per day (although we do have contingencies in place should someone need a little more than a half hour to finish their job application or what have you). Customers might start calling to make those appointments on Saturday, but the appointments don't start until Monday.

Please let me or your manager know if you have questions, suggestions, concerns, recommendations, whatever. We've got a plan in place to get us started. It's not perfect so we will be making adjustments as needs arise. But, the important thing is we are doing the best we can with the resources, experience, and knowledge we have right now. ### Curbside Pickup

Reserve your books, movies and more in advance: online at smrld.org, via email at research@smrld.org, or by phone 618-452-6238.

When you are notified that your items are ready, travel to your library location.  
**Johnson Rd - pick any spot in the parking lot, call 618-501-4798**  
**Delmar Ave - park on 20th St near the glass foyer, call 618-501-4793**

Library staff will place your materials on a table. After the staff have walked away you may pick them up. If you have mobility issues, please notify us in advance and staff may place the materials in your trunk.

The book drops are open at both libraries, so you may return your items & repeat!

Call 618-452-6238 or email research@smrld.org to schedule your **30 min per day appointment**. Services Include: Browsing; Computer Use; Job Search Help; Notary; Research; Tech Help; Scan/Copy/Fax; Passports; License Plate Renewals; and Hunting/Fishing Licenses.
