Dear Parent or Guardian:

Your child has been placed on emergency expulsion from school and must remain home from 9/16/2021 until 9/30/2021. The reason for emergency expulsion is: Hate Speech. This is a violation of School Board Policy 3241 and Procedure 3241P.

After investigating this matter, I have concluded there is good and sufficient reason to believe that [REDACTED] presence poses an immediate and continuing danger to other students or school staff or an immediate and continuing threat of material and substantial disruption of the educational process. The emergency expulsion being imposed meets this standard for the following reason(s): I hate black people in front of a student of color. The emergency expulsion may remain in place for up to (10) ten days unless rescinded earlier or converted to another form of discipline by me or modified or reversed pursuant to the appeal process described below.

During [REDACTED] emergency expulsion, the District will provide them with Homework support. [REDACTED] may contact Julia Howell at Julia.howell@sno.wednet.edu or (360)563-4160 for support with keeping current on their assignments and course work during the suspension.

A student on expulsion is not allowed on any school campus in the Snohomish School District or at any District-sponsored activity, except as otherwise specifically identified by the District for your student's receipt of educational services from the District in an alternative setting. Failure to comply with this regulation will result in further disciplinary action and legal authorities will be notified.

This situation is urgent and demands our immediate attention. Please contact me as soon as reasonably possible.

Emergency Expulsion Appeal Procedures

Definition: *An emergency expulsion is removal from school for up to ten consecutive school days because the student's presence poses an immediate and continuing danger to other students or school personnel or an immediate and continuing threat of material and substantial disruption of the education process; it must end or be converted to another form of corrective action with (10) ten school days of the emergency removal from school.*

Pursuant to WAC 392-400-520, you and the student may attempt to resolve any disagreement with the District's disciplinary decision through an informal conference with Eric Cahan. You may request this conference either orally or in writing by contacting Sherri Pickett at 360-563-4019. At this conference, Eric Cahan will listen to your perspective and explanation regarding the events that led to the emergency expulsion.

Regardless of whether you elect to participate in an informal conference with Eric Cahan, pursuant to WAC 392-400-525, you have t/he right to request an appeal hearing to contest the emergency expulsion. To obtain a hearing, you must submit a written or oral request for a hearing within (3) three school business days after your receipt of this letter to:


