

Third Amendment To Inmate Telephone Contract and Agreement

Spalding County Sheriff's Office, herein known as the "Customer" and ATN Inc./AmTel, herein known as AmTel are in agreement to amend the existing Inmate Telephone Contract and Agreement dated September 25, 2008, the Contractual Amendment dated April 3, 2013 and the Second Amendment dated January 12, 2016 as follows:

- 1.) The term of this agreement shall be from the last date signed and shall terminate on December 31, 2017. Upon termination of this agreement, each party agrees to satisfy any and all outstanding obligations arising under this agreement.
- 3.) Any future modifications to this document shall be in writing and signed by both parties.
- 5.) In consideration for this exclusive license and lease agreement Amtel shall pay the Customer a commission fee of sixty percent (60%) of Total Gross Revenue, which is defined as all completed calls regardless of call type. No deductions will be made for fraud, bad debt, or unbillable.

AmTel agrees to purchase a RMUS Public Safety Drone and Digital Ally body cameras as an up-front Technology Signing Bonus. Addendum 1 is a copy of the invoice from RMUS in the amount of \$ 10,770.40 and a copy of the invoice from Digital Ally in the amount of \$7440.00 relative to Spalding County Sheriff's Office. The Cell Sense Unit Plus System C3 Detector Serial # FSFG-04-0052, valued at \$12,995.00, will become the property of Spalding County Sheriff's Office upon execution of this contract.

This agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Georgia. IN WITNESS WHEREOF; AmTel and Customer have executed this Third Amendment to the Contract as of the date and year set forth below:
