Canales and the male got onto the elevator and went down towards the ground floor. When he left Canales was wearing a hospital gown. He leg was bandaged up and he was on crutches. Hospital staff believed he opened up the wound because they saw blood seeping through the bandages as he left.

did not follow Canales and did not see which way he went once he reached the ground floor. (End of Statement)

I went to Canales' hospital room to inspect it. There were numerous bloody bandages After speaking with on the bed. On his night stand I found a white piece of paper with phone number written on it. I called the number but it went straight to voice mail.

I informed Sgt Couvillion (2S41) of my findings. He directed me to drive to Canales' listed parole address to assist with a search of the residence.

A search was conducted and he was not located. Family members advised they have not seen or heard from him. After the search was conducted, a BOLO was sent out to area hospitals and surrounding law enforcement agencies with the incident details.

#### STATEMENT OF (VIC):

The interviewer begins by naming the victim. The interviewer asked if the name she stated was correct, the victim shook her name up and down indicating the name was correct. The interviewer asked again to confirm the name and the victim reaffirmed her answer by continuing to shake her head up and down.

The interviewer informed the victim that she would be asking her questions that will be simplified so she could answer them. The interviewer also told the victim to correct any statements that were incorrect or untrue and the victim indicated she would.

The interviewer asked if the victim if she would be truthful during the interview, the victim shook her head up and down and said "yes". She also showed the interviewer what no meant by shaking her head side to side and said "this is what no means". The victim seemed engaged in the conversation. She was sitting and responding to all the questions at that point.





I again explained to him that before I could give him any confidential information I needed to know who he was. He said, "I'm Mitchell Carrasco and this is my phone number. What would you like to know?" I asked him what his date of birth was. He said he was not going to tell me that. He said I could get that from his wife. I told him that would not help me identify him over the phone. He said it would not help him identify me either. He asked me what my date of birth and badge number was. I told him my badge number. He asked me what my phone number was. I told him my desk phone number. He said any other information I could get from his wife. He said he had nothing to hide and he was right there talking to me. He said he was not coming down unless I had something on him. He said, "I'll be right there so you can lock my ass up. Lock my ass up because that ain't me." I told him that was up to him and that I just wanted to get his side of the story. He told me I was getting it "right now". He asked me why she contacted me two months after she kicked him out of the house. I told him that I had already talked to her about all that. He then told me to have a great day and said if I wanted anything to call him up and he would talk to me about anything. I told him that he would not even give me his date of birth. I explained to him that I had Mitchell Carrasco's date of birth and identifying information but I did not know that he was Mitchell Carrasco. He said, "I'm Mitchell Carrasco what do you want. Nine, twenty, sixty-one." He asked what else I wanted. I asked him what his driver's license number was. He said he did not have it on him. I asked if he had his social. He said that was private information and he would not give that out. He said if I did not have anything on him that I was wasting his time. I asked him where he was. He said he was in Stockton. He asked me what I wanted to see him about that was so bad. He asked me if I had a case and something to "file" on him. I told him yes. He told me, "File and lets go to court." I asked him what his address was so that we could get that information to him. He said he was homeless. I asked where we would send stuff to him. He said he was homeless right now. He said he would try to go down and get a P.O. Box. He said I could send the stuff there. He asked when the court date was. I told him that I did not know that because I did not work for the courts. I told him that in order for me to interview him over the phone I needed to know who he was. He asked me what I needed. I again asked for his driver's license number. He said he did not have it on him. I asked him what his social security number was. He said he would give me that last four. He said that was all he was going to give me because he did not know if I was an officer. I asked him what address he was staying at. He said he was homeless. I asked him if he was just living on the street. He said yes. He said his wife kicked him out for cheating. He said this came out after he took his washer, dryer and big screen T.V. 	On July 31, 2015 Judge Michael Coughlan singed the Warrant and set the bail amount at \$1,250,000 for the charges of PC288.7(b) and PC288(a). I filed the warrant with the Stockton Police Department records section.
	l located an address for Mitchell's mother, from CH932 on 07-17-15 in which she called in a welfare check on Mitchell that she later canceled. I went to her address, located Mitchell's vehicle parked in the parking lot. The vehicle was a white Toyota pickup license plate number 5P57454. A DMV check of the vehicle revealed it was registered to Mitchell. Detective Egan and I knocked on door but received no answer.
-	On August 4, 2015 I went back to address but did not locate Mitchell's vehicle. I called advised me that Mitchell was not staying with her but that she had seen the week prior. She said she did not know where he was and did not know what was going on between him and . She said she did not want to know what was going on. I told her to have Mitchell come to the police department to speak with me.
	When I returned to the office I received a phone call from a man who identified himself as Mitchell. Mitchell gave me the following summarized statement:

to me. He said he was going to see his lawyer because he did not want to say anything that would incriminate himself. I asked him when he would be coming in. He said he was going to go see his lawyer to find out when he was free.

I told Mitchell that it was very important that he come down. He asked me why it was so important. He asked, "Are you guys going to beat the shit out of me?" He said, "That's why I need my lawyer. You guys are probably going to beat the fuck out of me. That's why I need my lawyer. You're threatening me." I told him that I was not threatening him at all. He then yelled, "Yeah you are. You are saying if I don't come down something is going to happen to me." I told him if he didn't come down he would be arrested in the middle of public or around his family and friends. Mitchell then yelled, "I don't give a fuck because I didn't do a fucking thing! They can come arrest me! I didn't do a fucking thing! That's why I need my lawyer there. For people like you who try to fucking talk shit and make me talk! Come on you already got me scared because you got me thinking you are going to beat the fuck out of me!" I asked Mitchell what made him think that. He then said that I told him that if we found him in the street we might beat him up. I told him that I had not threatened him once. He said he did not care and he would see me when his lawyer was free. He said if I wanted to press charges, that was fine but he would just bail out. He asked who was pressing charges. I told him that the State would. He asked if it was and . I told him that it was not up to a person to press charges it was up to the district attorney's office. Mitchell asked me if this was a misdemeanor or a felony. I told him it was a felony. He asked me what it "carried". I told him that I did not know and that it was up to the court. He said he was going to get his lawyer. I asked him when he would be coming down. He said he had to find out when his lawyer was free. I told him that I wanted to make sure I was around so I did not hold his lawyer up. He said if I wasn't there he would just get going then. I told him he would not be free to leave once he was here. He asked why not and said he would see the judge the next day. He said he would see the judge and the judge would set the bail and that would be that. He said he would come down and we would take care of this. I told him that I did not want to have his lawyer waiting around because I knew they cost by the hour. Mitchell said he was in no hurry to "eat your food". He said he would see me when he saw me. He told me to have a good week and said "late" before hanging up the phone. (END OF STATEMENT)

### NOTIFICATION:

On 08/26/15 at approx. 1500 hours, I (Officer M. Rodriguez), was working my current assignment in the Police and Corrections Team (PACT). I was driving a marked patrol unit equipped with lights and siren. I wearing a department approved uniform. I'm currently a K-9 handler for my department.

### **INVESTIGATION:**

I was assisting Detective Wong and the US Marshal's task force with attempting to locate (ARR) Carrasco. Carrasco had a Ramey warrant for 288.7(B)PC (sex with a child 10 years or younger) and 288(a)PC (lewd acts upon a child). Refer to the original report for further details.

Detective Wong advised me that Carrasco was possibly in Modesto. I arrived in the area and observed Carrasco's white pickup parked in front of 1310 Oregon Ave, Modesto.

The US Marshal's Task Force set up surveillance at 1310 Oregon Ave, Modesto. I heard over the radio a H/M, later identified as (SUB), was walking towards the passenger's side of the white pickup. A few seconds later. I heard a Task Force Officer air over the radio that Carrasco was walking towards the white pickup.

US Marshal's Task Force Agent J. Carbajal and I arrived in front of the residence. I observed Carrasco run away from the white pickup and towards the front door of 1310 Oregon Ave. Agent Carbajal yelled at Carrasco to stop and get on the ground. Carrasco ignored commands and continued to run towards the front door. I exited my patrol vehicle and deployed my K-9 "Cain" from my patrol vehicle. I walked towards the front of my patrol vehicle and yelled at Carrasco to stop or I was going to send my Police K-9 and he would bite him. Carrasco had keys in his hands and was trying to open the front door to the residence. Fearing Carrasco was going to flee inside the house and possible barricade himself, I gave my Police K-9 "Cain" a command to apprehend Carrasco.

I could see Carrasco still trying to open the front door. "Cain" ran towards Carrasco and made contact with Carrasco's left lower leg area near his calve. I ran towards Carrasco and pushed him towards the ground. Carrasco fell on the ground as "Cain" was still making contact with his left lower leg. I gave Carrasco commands to place his hands behind his back. I grabbed onto Carrasco's arms and placed them behind his back. I gave "Cain" a command to release Carrasco which he did. Other Agents arrived and placed Carrasco in handcuffs.

US Marshal's Task Force Agent C. Johnson requested for AMR to respond to medically treat Carrasco for his injuries. AMR Medic #21 responded and transported Carrasco to the county hospital. I requested FET to respond to conduct photographs of Carrasco's injuries. FET Officer Tracy responded and conducted the photographs. Carrasco had 2-3 lacerations on the front and back of his lower left leg. Each laceration was approx. 5-6 inches in length. Carrasco also had a bruise to the right side of his face.

Carrasco was pre-booked at the county hospital prior to being booked into the county jail.

Sgt. Benevides was advised of the situation.

On August 12, 2015 I received a voicemail from Attorney Mark Girdner who advised he was Mitchell's attorney and that he wanted to set up an appointment to have Mitchell come in and talk to me.

On August 13, 2015 I called Mark Girdner's office and got a hold of Mark. Mark advised me that he would try to get in touch with Mitchell to have him come in the following week. I advised Mark that Mitchell had a warrant out for his arrest and that he needed to turn himself in as soon as possible or risk being arrested in public.

On August 18, I called Mark Girdner's office back and was told Mark was out of the office. The secretary advised me that she would leave him a message for him to call me back.

I then contacted Detective Wong and advised him of Mitchell and the Ramey Warrant.

On August 21, 2015 I called Mark Girdner's office and again was told he was out of the office.

On August 26, 2015 I received a phone call from Detective Wong who advised me that the US Marshall's assisted with locating Mitchell in Modesto. Detective Wong advised me that Carrasco had been taken into custody after he tried to flee from officers. Detective Wong advised me that Mitchell was bitten by a police K9 and was going to be taken to San Joaquin General Hospital for treatment of his injuries.

I responded to the hospital where I met K9 Officer M. Rodriguez and members of the US Marshalls who had Mitchell in custody. Mitchel was still in the back of an ambulance waiting for the hospital to have an open room for treatment of his injuries. I was informed that Mitchell had several lacerations to his leg caused by the K9 deployment. For details refer to Officer M. Rodriguez's report. FET arrived and took photos of Mitchell while in the ambulance. Once a room was available Mitchell was taken into the hospital and placed in a bed.

Once Mitchell was settled into a room I entered and introduced myself. Mitchell was sitting in bed with a bandage on his leg. He had a small abrasion to his forehead. Mitchell was not handcuffed. I read Mitchell the Miranda Warning from my department issued Miranda Card. When asked if he understood the rights Mitchell said, "Yes". I asked Mitchell how he got there. Mitchell said, "I want to see my lawyer." I then stopped asking any questions related to the case. Mitchell advised me of his attorney's name and said his attorney had been in contact with me. He said he had been telling his attorney that he needed to go see me. He said he told his attorney he had nothing to hide. He said his attorney told him that I was on vacation. He said he had nothing to hide. He said he did not know "what the hell" his attorney was doing.

I advised Mitchell that he was being booked on a Ramey Warrant with a bail of \$1.2 million for two charges of sexual assault on a child. Mitchell asked me what child. I told Mitchell that I could not talk about the details until his lawyer was present with him if that was what he wanted. I then left the room.


