Narrative

(later known to be the arrestee Carlos Lara) into custody in the parking lot of Acambaro Meat Market. (Refer to Officer Adams' supplemental report for identifying information of the arrestee)

I saw numerous officers attempting to handcuff a male who was lying on the ground resisting as officers were trying to roll him over to gain access to his hands. Once he was rolled over (on his stomach facing down) he kept resisting by flexing his arms, not allowing officers to place handcuffs on him. I noticed that the male had blood coming out of his mouth, but I do not know what the cause was. I was advised by one of the officers to be careful with the male's right leg because it was injured. (Refer to these officer's supplemental reports for details on the incident)

I assisted in taking statements of the parties involved. I entered the store to speak to (VIC) Antonio Rodriguez who appeared exhausted as he was breathing heavily, and sweating. He gave me the following statement in summary:

STATEMENT OF (VIC1) ANTONIO RODRIGUEZ:

Carlos began to go into the store at approximately 1405 causing a disturbance to the employees and customers. He was harrassing the employees trying to fight them. He kept going to the kitchen area to bother the cooks by asking them for money. After they saw his demeanor they ordered him to get out of the store but he kept advancing toward them aggressively. They realized that ordering him out was not working so they used force to push him out of the store for the first time. Once they were able to push him out by using a broom stick he slipped and fell in front of the parking lot. Carlos went in approximately 6 times after that. The employees would kick him out everytime by ordering him to leave and pushing him out, but he kept returning.

Everytime he would go in he would grab merchandise from the shelves and throw it all over the store. Carlos kept trying to hit him, and his employees, so they began to push him out of the store using a broom stick.

He asked Carlos what he wanted, if he wanted food he would give him food but only if he would agree to leave. Carlos told him that he did not want food, he only wanted to fight.

Carlos constantly goes into the store and causes similar disturbances. He has seen Carlos behave this way before numerous times. He thinks it is due to his heavy drug use and alcohol. consumption. He noticed that when police arrived numerous officers were attempting to gain his compliance. It was difficult for them to take control of him because he was being aggressive with them as well, but eventually they did.

INVESTIGATION (continued):

I contacted (VIC 2) Sixto Hernandez who is an employee at Acambaro Meat Market and he gave me the following statement in summary:

STATEMENT OF (VIC 2) SIXTO HERNANDEZ:

Carlos had been at the store since 8 in the morning. He originally arrived with another male whom he did not know. They both left and Carlos returned later in the day because he wanted to talk to him. He refused to talk to him because he was too busy working but Carlos refused to leave him alone.

At one point, Carlos took a fighting stance and tried to hit him. He clenched his left fist and punched him on his left side chin. Carlos did not hit him hard, but he did feel his fist hit his chin. He told him to calm down numerous times but he would not listen. He called for his boss, Antonio, to help him control Carlos. They both made numerous attempts to get him out of the store but he kept going inside trying to fight them and throwing the store's merchandise on the ground. He noticed that Carlos kept going in and out of the store, and he observed him fall on his own a couple of times while he was in front of the parking lot. He kept going back inside harrassing the employees and kicking merchandise. They pushed him outside using a broom stick and he fell to the ground. The police arrived at this time and took charge of the situation.

Notification: On July 6, 2017 at approximately 1446 hours, I (Sgt. Farthing/AD33), heard 2D25 (Johnson/Adams), request a code three fill to 320 S. El Dorado St.

Investigation: I was driving a marked black and white SPD Ford Explorer #4145, which was equipped with emergency lights and siren. I was wearing a class B patrol uniform and an external vest carrier, with patches affixed to the shoulder of my shirt and my badge pinned to the outside of my vest carrier.

I responded code three from Center St./Washington St., arriving at approximately 1447 hours.

Upon arrival, Officers Johnson/Adams were holding the suspect on the ground with an unknown citizen, who was helping to hold the suspect's legs. I took the citizen's position at the suspects feet, in order to control the suspect's legs.

The suspect was facedown, with his right arm on the right side of his body, and his left arm underneath his body. Officer Johnson and Adams had control of the suspect's right arm, which they gave to me. I placed a handcuff onto the suspect's right arm, and maintained control of his arm.

The suspect was trying to pull his arm away from me, and moving his body. I maintained control of the suspect's right arm, but I noticed his right knee appeared dislocated.

Several other officers arrived and assisted with handcuffing the suspect. We were able to handcuff the suspect using two sets of handcuffs. Because the suspect was moving around, I was concerned he may try to move his handcuffs to the front of his body. I had the officers place him into a single set of handcuffs, to keep him from moving around and possibly injuring himself more.

Sgts. Hernandez and Thurlow arrived on-scene and relieved me from the scene.

NOTIFICATION:

On 07/06/2017 (Thursday) at 1443 hours, Officer Johnson and I (Officer Adams) wearing full class b uniform in a marked patrol vehicle, were dispatched to 320 S El Dorado Ave. (Acambaro Meat Market) on a report of a disturbance. We arrived on scene at 1445 hours.

INVESTIGATION:

The text of the call stated a hispanic male adult wearing a black shirt and jeans was walking in and out of the store causing a disturbance with employees, and trying to fight them. It appeared to the reporting party the subject was under the influence of narcotics.

While enroute to the call, I was stopped at the intersection of E Sonora St. and S El Dorado Ave. facing east. I looked at the call location and observed a person matching the suspect description (later identified as Carlos Lora) raising his fists attempting to strike what was later identified as an employee of the business (Refer to Officer Lopez's original report for employee's statement). The employee had a broom in his hands and was pointing the brush end of the broom at Lora.

Lora took a fighting stance and brought his right fist behind him and attempted to strike the employee.

I activated my marked patrol vehicle's lights and siren and drove into the parking lot of 320 S El Dorado Ave. I approached Lora and instructed him to put his hands behinds his head. Lora continued to attempt to strike the store employee. I grabbed Lora's right arm with both of my hands in an attempt to place him into a control hold.

Lora pulled away from me and shifted his weight as if to strike me with his right elbow. I grabbed Lora's right arm

again in an attempt to place him into a control hold and told Lora to get onto his stomach. Lora pulled away again and grabbed Officer Johnson. Officer Johnson and I attempted to pull Lora to the ground to get him under control.

I requested a code three fill to assist us in taking Lora into custody.

Officer Johnson and I forced Lora to the ground and attempted to place his hands behind his back. Lora continued to struggle and force his hands to his front waistband. Lora began kicking Officer Johnson with his feet.

I struck Lora two times on his right lower shin with my baton and told him to lay on his stomach. As I swung a third time, Lora raised his knee up from the ground, causing my baton to strike his knee area.

Lora was able to place his feet beneath him, and stood up. Lora struck Officer Johnson with his forehead. Officer Johnson and I continued to struggle with Lora in an attempt to take him into custody.

Officer Johnson stated we should attempt to hold him to the ground until more units arrive.

Officer Johnson, the store employee, and I, forced Lora to the ground and held Lora down until additional officers arrived.

Officer Skeels (2A41) and Officer Gonzalez (2A77) arrived and assisted us in getting Lora's hands behind his back and searching him.

I requested medics to respond and treat injuries sustained by Lora during the fight. AMR Medic #102 and Stockton Fire Squad #2 responded to treat Lora's injuries.

I followed AMR Medic #102 as they transported Lora to the San Joaquin County Hospital. Officer Johnson rode inside the ambulance with Lora.

Field Evidence Technician Haro (2L27) arrived to the hospital and photographed Lora's injuries.

BODY CAMERA:

(The following interviews/investigation was digitally recorded via a body worn camera and has been summarized below. The purpose of the summary is to render an overview of what was described; however, they are not transcriptions of the recorded interviews. The summary should not be viewed as containing only the important facts of the interviews. They are intended to provide the reader with a general understanding of what was said; therefore, refer to the recording itself for the exact wording.)

INVESTIGATION:

Officer Adams and I were traveling E/B Sonora St. from Center St. in our marked patrol car. As we approached El Dorado St. I could see a subject, later identified as Carlos Lora, wearing a black shirt and dark pants in front of the business. He was almost immediately in front of the entry/exit doors. I saw two males standing in the doorway (later determined to be store clerks) and appeared to be preventing Carlos from entering the business. Carlos was trying to punch the clerks. I saw one clerk swinging a broom at Carlos to keep him away.

Officer Adams activated our overhead emergency lights to negotiate our way through traffic. He pulled into the parking lot and we exited our patrol car in full uniform. Carlos had backed away from the clerks but then quickly approached them again in an attempt to hit them. I removed my RCB (Rapid Containment Baton) from my belt and extended it open. I held the baton over my right shoulder as we ordered Carlos to get onto the ground. Carlos did not comply and continued to advance towards the clerks. I noticed that Carlos was bleeding from his face near his nose and mouth but did not know why. I put the baton back on my belt. Officer Adams and I pulled Carlos to the ground.

Carlos rolled onto his back as we were trying to hold him down. I grabbed onto one of his wrists with my left hand and used my right hand to grab Carlos by the throat to pin him down. Carlos was not very big in size but was strong as if he was under the influence of narcotics. He was sweating profusely and hard to hold onto. Carlos was kicking me in my lower legs and attempted to stand up. He bumped me causing me to fall backwards onto my knees and left elbow. By this time one of the clerks had responded to assist us in arresting Carlos.

Officer Adams and the clerk were trying to hold Carlos down but he continued to kick at them and was trying to get up. I pulled my RCB out again. I hit Carlos in each leg, below the knee, two or three times. It appeared that my RCB was not effective so I put it back on my belt and approached Carlos again to attempt handcuffing. As I neared Carlos he lunged forward and hit my on my chest and face with the top of his head. I could taste the sweat from his head in my mouth. Officer Adams and I called for code 3 assistance from additional units.

I could hear patrol car sirens approaching. Since it appeared that Carlos didn't feel the previous baton strikes I decided it would not work a second time. I told Officer Adams and the clerk that we would just hold Carlos on the ground until additional Officers arrived.

Officers Skeels-2A41 and Officer E. Gonzalez-2A77 arrived. With their assistance we were able to handcuff Carlos.

It appeared that Carlos had a compound fracture to his right leg. AMR Unit #102 and Stockton Fire Squad #2 arrived to treat him.

Sgt. Hernandez-2S34 had responded to assist. He was advised of the use of force and the fact that when Carlos knocked me down I twisted my right knee and hit my left elbow on the ground.

Officers Lopez/Breckenridge-2D27 arrived to assist. Officer Lopez spoke with the store clerks. Refer to her report for their statements.

I rode in the back of the ambulance while Carlos was being transported to San Joaquin General Hospital for treatment. Officer Adams and Officer Skeels followed us.

FET Adams responded to the hospital to take photographs of Carlos. I noticed he had abrasions/red marks on his left leg below the knee. I also noticed that Carlos was bleeding from his right shin from a laceration and appeared to have a compound fracture.

While at the hospital I noticed I had blood from Carlos' face on the front of my shirt from where he hit me with his head. FET Adams also took photographs of my uniform and knee.

I spoke with Sgt. Hernandez and advised him that the charges against Carlos were all misdemeanor. I also advised him that it appeared Carlos was going to stay for surgery. He gave us permission to leave Carlos at the hospital and refer the case to the D.A. for review.

Due to the fact that Carlos was under the influence of something and not talking/responding to us, I did not take a statement.

Officers Breckenridge/Skeels/Lopez remained at the hospital with Carlos until relieved by Officers Thalen/Alvarez-3D43.

NOTIFICATION:

On 07-06-17, at 1447 hours, I (Officer Skeels, 2A41) responded code 3 with my emergency lights and sirens to assist officers involved in fight with a subject. I responded from Hunter St. and Washington St. and arrived at 1448 hours.

INVESTIGATION:

On arrival, I parked my patrol vehicle to block the number three lane of El Dorado St. I exited my patrol vehicle and observed Officers Johnson and Adams holding a Hispanic male prone on the ground. The male, later identified as (ARR) Carlos Lora was still kicking his feet and attempting to roll over onto his back. Lora had a very tense muscle tone and was bleeding from the face area. Officer Johnson pointed out to me that Lora's right, lower leg was broken from a baton strike.

An officer had Lora's right hand behind his back with a handcuff placed on the wrist. Lora's left hand was still tucked underneath his body. I placed my handcuffs onto Lora's left wrist and handed it off to Officer E.Gonzalez. I took control of Lora's right arm as Officer Gonzales pulled Lora's left arm behind his back. I placed my right knee behind Lora's right shoulder blade to keep his chest down on the ground. Lora continued to resist and attempt to roll around on the ground. He made moaning and whining noises, but no comprehensible words. We used both handcuffs to link together to initially get Lora's hands secure. Lora was able to continue to reach around into his pockets to grab at items with two handcuffs on. Sgt. Hernandez requested Lora be placed into one set of handcuffs. I maintained control of Lora's right arm while Officer Gonzalez placed Lora into a single pair of handcuffs. Refer to additional reports for details.

I assisted move Lora into the shade due to the high temperature of the day being 99 degrees farenheit. Extra caution was taken to ensure Lora's injured leg was not manipulated more than necessary to move him from the hot pavement into the shade. I placed my left knee down in between Lora's legs as he lay prone. This position allowed me to keep him from shifting his body left or right as well as restricted his leg movement. Medical staff
