

09/03/2008: I received a cel phone call from Sgt. DiRoma who advised that Montvale, NJ PD called our HQ and advised that they have signed charges on PO Mike Greco stemming from a domestic dispute. I contacted Sgt. Hanna of Montvale PD and he relayed the following. PO Greco's wife responded to their station this afternoon and requested an OOP from their jurisdiction as she stated that she and PO Greco had a domestic dispute. While at HQ officers observed redness to her neck area and she made a statement that Greco pulled a necklace off of her neck. Due to this redness and NJ law the officers completed charges for Simple Assault which according to Sgt. Hanna is the equivalent of a misdemeanor in NY. Sgt. Hanna stated that they were trying to locate Greco to have him turn himself in so they could process him. I contacted Greco via Nextel and advised him of the above and he responded to HQ to meet me along with PBA President Sgt. John Mallon. Greco and Mallon responded to Montvale PD where Greco was processed and released on \$100 bail. An OOP was also issued against Greco at this time. I contacted Mayor Keegan and Village Attorney Terry Rice and advised them of the above. Terry advised me to put PO Greco out on administrative leave for the week and the following week Greco is off on vacation. We will reevaluate the situation during that time.

D/SGT. SHEEHAN AND MYSELF RESPONDED TO MONTVALE PD AND SPOKE WITH SGT.HANNA & PO CRUISE ABOUT THE INCIDENT INVOLVING PO GRECO. BOTH OFFICERS CONFIRMED THE INFORMATION IN THE REPORT TO BE WHAT MRS.GRECO HAD STATED OCCURED. SGT.HANNA STATED THAT A CHECK OF THEIR COMPUTER SYSTEM SHOWED NO HISTORY OF DOMESTIC INCIDENTS INVOLVING PO GRECO AND HIS WIFE. SGT.HANNA FURTHER STATED THAT MRS.GRECO DID NOT WANT TO PURSUE CHARGES, BUT BECAUSE OF NJ DOMESTIC VIOLENCE LAWS IT WAS A MANDATORY ARREST. SGT.HANNA BELIEVES THAT MRS.GRECO WILL NOT PURSUE THE MATTER IN COURT. COPIES OF THE PICTURES TAKEN AT THE POLICE STATION OF MRS.GRECO WERE PLACED IN THE FILE FOLDER.

Notes:

1. Secure Weapons: Sgt. Bonkoski will contact Greco and assure that all weapons are in his locker, will be placed in evidence locker.
2. Get copies of OOP and all reports: Sgt. Bonkoski contacting Montvale PD.
3. Administrative Leave: Leave out for week, have him take vacation for next few weeks.
4. Check wording on OOP.
5. Interviews: Interview officer, complainant and all officers from Montvale involved.
6. Check with DA if he can still carry weapon.
7. Talk to prosecutor in NJ about any restrictions
8. Internal charges: Have 60 days to follow

09/18/2008 1408: Sgt Bonkoski and I interviewed Mrs. [REDACTED] in the training room of the Suffern Police Department Headquarters regarding the incident that led to the arrest of Officer Michael Greco in Montvale New Jersey on 09/03/2008.

Mrs. Greco said that it had been a stressful year leading up to the incident with her husband Michael Greco. [REDACTED] said that she and Michael had been looking for a home in New York so that his and her family could move in together and finally have a normal family life together while attempting to sell her home in Montvale. Several homes had been looked at in the area, with unsuccessful bids submitted. A home was finally found in Washingtonville, NY, the bid was accepted and she finally got a buyer for her home and had just sent the contract to her attorney for review.

[REDACTED] added that while the home sale and purchasing was going on, she had medical difficulties with her daughter because of a [REDACTED] and the subsequent high cost of the medical care increased the stress between her and Michael.

[REDACTED] added that Michael was also having a "cold war" with his daughter which added to the stress going on

[REDACTED] said that Michael became angry and irrational while at her home on 09/03/2008 and that she had gone to her car to leave and get away from the turmoil, with Michael following, yelling and screaming that she did not love him. While she was in the car, Michael leaned in the window saying something about her necklace and had it in his hand. [REDACTED] said that was so afraid of Michael's anger, she jumped back away from him, breaking the necklace and snagging her bracelet on the lower portion of the driver's seat. [REDACTED] said that Michael did not assault her and take the necklace, she merely pulled away from him and the necklace broke.

[REDACTED] said she now realizes that it was stress brought on by all the difficulties she and Michael had during the past year that led to his outburst at her home. [REDACTED] said that she feels that Michael should not be penalized for what had occurred, that it was all related to private family matters and feels Michael should talk to a professional to find out why he is so angry.

It should be noted that the order of protection in Bergen County NJ Family Court was rescinded and the charge of simple assault in Montvale NJ was dismissed.

[REDACTED] was advised that Sgt Bonkoski and I (Sgt Sheehan) would recommend that Michael Greco be referred to the Employee Assistance Program for counseling.

Summary of Background To Occurrence-

1. Michael's dispute with me involved a family matter and his love or lack of it for me. It did not involve anything that would affect his job.
2. I am not experienced with domestic dispute matters, do not come from a family of policeman and have never even dated a policeman before, no less married one. The extent of my limited knowledge of these matters is that in the few cases I have heard of where a spouse is out of control (usually drunk) and their spouse feels a need to be protected from irrational behavior, the police have provided protection and the restrained spouse only temporarily to allow them to cool off from their irrational behavior and then made to go to marriage or other counseling (or AA, if drunkenness was the root of the problem).
3. I was frightened by Michael's unexplained and to me, irrational, behavior and when it continued from the night before, throughout the day and while I was trying to go to my car to get away from the screaming and awful name calling, I was put in a type of panic/shock (from not understanding the whole behavior that had been relentless and from flashbacks to similar irrational outbursts that sent my daughter into a rage that was equally as frightening and from seeing her rage, Michael told me he was afraid to be alone with her and from simultaneous flashbacks the occurrence caused me to have, to scenes I witnessed from a very abusive step father).
4. I was leaving the house to get in my car to escape the hours of yelling and name calling when Michael ran after me and said he wanted my ring back. From the second I heard him behind me I went into a shock/panic mode and my only thoughts were to flee the anger I could not understand.
5. When I was seated in the car, Michael leaned in to show me something on the pendant on my necklace. I instinctively drew back and in the second that I did so my bracelet caught on the side seat button, pulling on it and my necklace broke on my neck. My injury was accidental and from my own fear that was magnified by the flashbacks the screaming had brought back to me. At the time it happened I only recalled Michael leaning in, my wrist being pulled and my necklace breaking. When I calmly recounted the day and reflected on each step, I realized that I had jumped back out of my own fear and confusion in the anger and that is what caused my injury.
6. My confusion and the irrationality of the anger I heard was intensified because on this particular day, Michael should have been the happiest. After a very difficult year, with a lot of sacrifice on both of our parts, we finally had the light at the end of the tunnel in front of us. The house we had been looking for over a year for had been found, with one glitch waiting to be cleared and backup houses being selected (in fact we were to look at a few the next day to make sure we had something to close on in October). My house, which we had also been trying to sell for over a year, finally had a buyer and a proposed closing date of November. I had just delivered the contract of sale to the buyer's attorney that morning. All the kids were back in college and we had our "us"

time back. We had worked so hard to get everything to fit together and it was right in front of us.

7. Michael's shouting that I didn't love him was so irrational I could not understand it. I had given up both a law job that I was happy at and an adjunct professor position at RCC because Michael was uncomfortable with my working there and preferred I take a teaching job to spend more time with him. The teaching job was a horror and I had to work longer hours and under terrible conditions, not Michael's fault, it just added to the roughness of the year.
8. Because Michael had to have his permanent address in New York, his apartment had no room for my children, I am the only parent my children have and they need a home to come home to and my NJ house was the only place available for them until it sold, the contracts we had on a house in Greenwood Lake and then Chestnut Ridge were outbid and the affordable house we found in Washingtonville did not come about till June/July, Michael and I had to live on a Merry-Go-Round of sleeping in one house or the other, often eating dinner in a different house than we slept in that day or night and just running back and forth between our two different primary residences, in order to be together. In an otherwise ideal situation this kind of physical separation is extremely damaging on any marriage, with two families to merge and two sets of kids who need to be assured that there is a solid commitment to a marriage and combined family life (when for a year there was not one single home to live in), my awful job situation and now unemployment, the strain of trying to find an affordable house that everyone can live happily in as one family, the stress of not being able to wake up next to each other every day in the first year of our marriage and the additional stress that my house not only had high mortgages, but one of them was held by my ex-boyfriend (so the ghost of my ex-boyfriend would not leave Michael's thoughts until my house was sold and that mortgage paid off), all combined to make the first year very stressful on both Michael and I.
9. Adding to an already full plate of stress, additional stress was that my daughter had two very scary episodes when her medication was not right and the medical bills have been a nightmare and caused additional stress from the associated claims paperwork and non payment nightmare. And not without stress from Michael's side, his daughter has been in a cold-war with him since December.
10. Previous to the day in question, Michael had several times had anger bursts, threatened to leave and never be seen again, even had left and disappeared to his apartment for 3-4 days, but he had always calmed down and had never been screaming at me for hours and over two days and calling me horrible names. This time was different and at a time when he should have been really happy. I couldn't understand what was happening and it reminded me of my daughter's episode so much.
11. All in all, the blending would have been much smoother, much sooner if we could have been in one combined family home from the beginning. But we couldn't, so it wasn't until the week this happened that I finally breathed a sigh of relief that finally, finally things could be right the way both Michael and I wanted them to be. He was happy and seemed relieved until the night before

I P.O. Michael A. Greco am writing this special report at the direction of Suffern Police Chief Clarke Osborn, for a incident that took place in Montvale, New Jersey on September 3, 2008. As I have been ordered to write this report, nothing contained in the report or obtained as a result of information contained in the report can be used against me criminally.

On September 3, 2008 at approximately 1630 hours, my wife [REDACTED] and myself had a dispute over money and children issues where both of us became upset, names were called by both of us. I had advised her that I was going to be leaving her home and not returning. That is when she advised me that I was not welcome there anymore with that I asked her to remove a gold badge that was around her neck. She instead said take the bracelet too, she took off the bracelet, then was attempting to take the necklace off and could not get it off I went to help her take it off, thats when she said I am not going to give it to you and pulled away causing the chain to break, After that she left the area. I then gathered my belongings, and went to my home in Washingtonville, New York. At no time did I threaten or physically hit my wife [REDACTED]

At approximately 2030 hours a Washingtonville Police Officer came to my home and advised me that Montvale Police Department wanted me to call them. I called Montvale P.O. and they advised me that my wife [REDACTED] had signed a Simple Assault charge on me for a red mark on her neck. I then advised Chief Osborn of the incident and that I was being charged in Montvale New Jersey.

I along with Suffern PBA president John Mallon went to Montvale P.O. Where I was processed on the Simple Assault charge, and given (TOR). I was released on \$100.00 bail with a return court date on October 1, 2008 at 1600 hours I also have a court date for the temporary order of restraint, on September 12, 2008 at 0900 hours.

On September 3,2008 you were involved in a domestic incident with your wife [REDACTED] at her home in Montvale New Jersey. This incident caused [REDACTED] to fear her safety and respond to the Montvale Police Department to request an Order of Protection. After taking statements from [REDACTED] the Montvale Police investigation determined that a violation of the New Jersey's Domestic Violence had occurred. The law requires that a mandatory arrest for Simple Assault along with a Temporary Restraining Order be issued because of the allegations against you.

The Suffern Police Department is aware that the Charges and Temporary Restraining Order in this matter have been dismissed in the courts and no further legal proceedings are pending. The Suffern Police Department has conducted it's own Internal Investigation into this matter. As you know Police Officers are held to a higher standard and are closely scrutinized by the public and media when incidents like this occur. The Suffern Police Department must maintain the publics trust that we take incidents like this seriously, while treating all involved equally, fairly and legally.

It has been determined after the Internal Investigation that the Suffern Police Department is ordering you to seek counseling through the Rockland County Policeman Benevolent Association, Employee Assistance Program (EAP). All services through the EAP are held in the strictest of confidence and the Suffern Police Department will not be advised of anything that is discussed. All that is required is that we receive proof that you attend such program within the next 60 days.

With the information that we have at this time no further action will be taken.



██████████ came to MPDHO to report an incident of Domestic Violence involving her husband, Michael Greco. ██████████ explained to me that during an argument Michael grabbed her necklace and pulled it off her neck. Michael also tore a bracelet off ██████████ left wrist. Red marks were observed on ██████████ neck and left wrist. Photographs were taken of her injuries. While getting further information, it was learned that Michael is employed as a Police Officer in Suffern, NY. ██████████ stated that Michael does not store or bring any firearms at his New Jersey home. He has a second home at ██████████

██████████ filled out a voluntary statement detailing the incident. The Crisis Response Team was offered but declined. The Victim Notification form was signed, a Temporary Restraining Order was requested, and a copy was given to ██████████ then appeared before Judge Michael DeMarrias. After hearing testimony, Judge DeMarrias issued the Temporary Restraining Order. Warrant 2008-000117 charging Michael with simple assault was also issued by Judge DeMarrias. Bail was set at \$1000.00 with a 10% option.

Michael was notified of the charges and was instructed to come to MPDHO to complete all necessary paperwork. Sgt. Hanna notified the Suffern Police Chief of the charges that were issued.

At 2210 Hrs. Greco arrived at MPDHO. He was fingerprinted and photographed by PO McDowell. The TRO return of service was signed, one copy was placed in the TRO file and another copy was given to Greco. One hundred dollars bail was posted by Greco and he was given a receipt. We attempted to notify ██████████ that Michael had been served but no one was home. A message was left and contact will be attempted again tomorrow.

At 1703 hrs., Sgt Hanna, and P.O. Cruise were met at headquarters by ██████████ who stated that she had been assaulted by her husband Michael, in the driveway of 110 Upper Saddle River Rd., Montvale. ██████████ had visible signs of injury to her neck, and wrist, which was consistent with the statement she gave regarding the assault. I photographed the injuries on her neck, as P.O. Cruise, and Det. Diblasi initiated the Domestic Violence complaint, and ██████████ Grecos' request for a temporary restraining order. Judge Demarrais later found probable cause to issue both the T.R.O., and the Domestic Violence complaint for simple assault. I was advised by Det. Sanfilippo that he had spoken to First Asst. Prosecutor William Galda in regards to this incident due to the fact that Michael Greco is employed as a police officer in Suffern New York. Prosecutor Galda stated that Suffern Police must be notified of the incident, and since it involves an officer from another state, we do not confiscate any weapons. Note: Judge Demarrais indicated a prohibition of weapons on the T.R.O., but only in the state of NJ. After the T.R.O., and domestic violence complaint for assault were signed by Judge Demarrais, I contacted the Washingtonville NY police (845-496-9123) and asked them to make a notification to Michael Greco to contact this agency. I then contacted the Suffern Police, and was put in contact with Chief Clark Osborn. I advised him of the situation, and he stated he would contact Michael Greco, and have him respond to this agency. Michael Greco arrived at headquarters at approx. 2200 hrs., was processed by P.O. McDowell, served with the T.R.O. and complaint, posted bail, and was released. ██████████ was then notified of his release.

Voluntary Statement (not under arrest)

I, [REDACTED], am not under arrest for, nor am I being detained for any criminal offenses concerning the events I am about to make known to Sgt. Hanna without being accused of or questioned about any criminal offenses regarding the facts I am about to state, I volunteer the following information of my own free will, for whatever purpose it may serve.

Sept. 3, 2008 ~ 5PM - My husband, Michael Greco, after an evening + day of verbal abuse, ordered me to eat with him. When I sat at the table he continued to verbally abuse me he called me a "cunt" and accused me of having an affair with an elderly ex-business partner. When I got up to walk away from the abuse he told me if I didn't sit back down he swore "to Christ" he would leave forever + never be seen by me. After weeks of verbal threats and his not paying bills and continuously belittling me, I told him that if he wanted to leave that badly, maybe he should. He started screaming at me + calling me more abusive names and I walked outside to my car. He called after me that he wanted his engagement ring, I said it was mine. He came running after me + grabbed my neck. He ripped my necklace off my neck - hurting my neck. He grabbed my arm + tried to rip off my bracelet. It did not come off - he demanded I remove it so I took it off + gave it to him. He opened the car door and said he wouldn't let me leave. (This is before the bracelet removal). He took the bracelet + I closed the door + drove to the police station.

I want a record of what he did to me, but I don't want him arrested. He has anger issues and doesn't realize how bad he gets. I want him to be helped, not to hurt him.
