There is probable cause to believe that Meghan S. Geddes (110578) committed the crime(s) of Driving Under the Influence.

This belief is predicated on the following facts and circumstances:

On 12/3/06 at approximately 0145 hours I responded to a single car non-injury traffic collision in the area of 14200 Redmond WY. Upon arrival I observed a white VW in a ditch on the side of the roadway, nearly on its side. There was collision related debris and dirt in the roadway and tire marks across the roadway and sidewalk leading to the vehicle.

I spoke to suspect Meghan Geddes who was standing several feet from the vehicle with a passerby. Geddes stated that it was her car and that she had parked it in the ditch "on Thursday" (today is Sunday). I had driven by the location earlier in the evening and the car was not there. As Geddes spoke I noted that her words were slurred and I detected the odor of intoxicants coming from her breath and person. I asked Geddes if she would submit to voluntary field sobriety tests and she stated she would. During the tests Geddes demonstrated multiple signs of impairment, and was placed under arrest for DUI. She was booked at the Redmond Police station and released to be charged through investigation.

#### 10. Incident:

On 12/3/06 at approximately 0140 hours I responded to the scene of a single car non-injury traffic collision in the 14200 block of Redmond WY, in the city of Redmond, King County WA. Upon my arrival I observed a white Volkswagon Beetle (WA#866PGM) in a ditch on the west side of NE 80 PL where it intersects with Redmond WY. I observed that the vehicle was facing the south, and that it was rolled almost completely onto the driver side in the ditch. I observed a large amount of freshly disturbed earth and what appeared to be vehicle pieces strewn in the roadway. Standing a short distance from the Volkswagon I observed 2 females standing and talking. The two were later identified as Diane L. Pritt (7/17/46) and Meghan S. Geddes (11/5/78). Pritt explained that she had called 911 when she came upon the scene as a passerby.

#### PERSONAL OBSERVATION:

I asked Geddes if the Volkswagon belonged to her, and she stated that it did, and that she had "parked" the vehicle in the ditch "on Thursday." As Geddes spoke I immediately detected a strong odor of intoxicants coming from her breath and person. I noted that her words were thick and badly slurred as she spoke to me. Her eyes appeared bloodshot, and I noted that Geddes had mud smeared on her pant legs and on her shoes. I asked Geddes again to explain to me how her vehicle came to end up in the ditch and she again explained that she had parked it there on Thursday. I asked why she was there now with the vehicle and she stated that she was there because her parents were going to pick her up. also explained that she lived a short distance away near Rose Hill Junior High, where she is employed as a teacher. Geddes denied that she had been driving the vehicle or crashed it into its location in the ditch. Geddes' responses to my questions were clearly not sensible, and given her responses plus my observation of her condition I asked her if she would submit to voluntary field sobriety tests. Geddes stated that she would take the tests. Geddes stated to me that she was not injured.

#### PRE-ARREST SCREENING:

I have been trained to conduct standardized field sobriety tests according to NHTSA standards. I conducted the following field sobriety tests:

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus-

I observed that Geddes displayed equal tracking in both eyes. She displayed equal pupil size. Geddes displayed lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes. I observed distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes. I observed onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in both eyes, in fact nystagmus was visible from nearly the instant the stimulus (my pen) left the centerline of Geddes' face. I did not observe vertical nystagmus.

#### Walk and Turn-

I explained and demonstrated the heel to toe starting position for the test and instructed Geddes to maintain the position as I continued the instructions. Geddes was wearing shoes with a wide heel approximately 2" high. Geddes swayed as I explained the instructions and lifted her arms from her sides several times to maintain her balance. Geddes stated that she understood the instructions for the test. I instructed Geddes to begin the test. Geddes lifted her arms from her sides for balance almost continuously throughout the test. I had to remind her to look down at her feet on several occasions. On the first set of steps Geddes missed heel to toe on steps 2,3,5,7, and 9. She stepped off line on steps 2,5, and 7. Geddes took 10 steps instead of 9 as she was instructed. Geddes did not turn as instructed, instead she spun around rapidly on one foot, nearly falling over as she did so. Geddes then looked at me and I had to remind her to take the second set of 9 steps. Geddes did not miss heel to toe or step off line on any of the steps, however she did not look at her feet or keep her arms at her side for most of the steps. Geddes again took 10 steps instead of 9 as instructed.

One Leg Stand-

I explained and demonstrated the starting position to Geddes. As I continued with the instructions Geddes swayed slightly from side to side and front to back. She stated that she did not understand the instructions and I repeated them a second time. Geddes said she understood and began the test before I instructed her to do so. Geddes did not count by the manner I instructed (1001, 1002.) instead counting out "1,2,3,." She used her arms for balance throughout the test. She swayed continuously during the test. Geddes put her foot down on the count of 13 and I had to remind her to continue the test.

Based on my physical observations of Geddes, the unusual statements she had made in explaining the situation, and her performance on the field sobriety tests, I placed Geddes under arrest for DUI at 0153 hours. I advised her of CR 3.1 and read her constitutional rights from my department issued officer handbook. Ofc. Haines conducted a search of her person and placed her in my patrol car.

I observed the scene of the collision more closely. I observed tire scuff marks beginning in the westbound lanes of Redmond WY approximately 100 yards east of the final location of the Volkswagon. The marks continued over the curbing separating eastbound and westbound Redmond

WY, over the sidewalk on the south side of Redmond WY, and up to the ditch where the vehicle came to rest. Several pieces of what appeared to be parts of the vehicle's undercarriage were visible in the roadway. I observed puddles of what appeared to be transmission fluid on the sidewalk near where the undercarriage of the car struck the curb. I looked inside of the Volkswagon and it did not appear that the airbags had deployed. I observed mud on the front seats of the vehicle. Due to the vehicle's tilted position it appears that Geddes exited from the passenger door. Due to the vehicle's awkward position I did not believe it was safe to enter the vehicle to conduct a search incident to arrest.

#### ADMINISTRATIVE PROCESSING:

I transported Geddes to the Redmond Police station for booking and processing. Ofc. Hovenden remained behind to await the impound tow. Upon arrival in booking I instructed Geddes to remove her jewelry to include her tongue ring. I conducted a mouth check at 0216 and found no foreign objects in her mouth. I advised Geddes of her constitutional rights from the WSP DUI Packet and she signed her understanding and waiver of rights at 0219 hours. I read Geddes the implied consent warning for breath and she signed her understanding at 0221 hours. Geddes stated that she would submit to a breath test. Geddes answered the WSP DUI Interview questions, admitting that she had been driving the vehicle prior to the collision. Geddes stated that she had been drinking with friends at home and at Pegasus Pizza in Kirkland earlier She stated that she had consumed 4 glasses of wine in the evening. She stated that she was on her way between 1700 hours and 2200 hours. Geddes stated that she did not know home at the time of the collision. how fast she had been going and that she believed that her vehicle slid on the sand in the road that had been put down several days earlier due to icy conditions. There was no ice on the roadway at the time of the collision.

At the conclusion of the 15 minute observation period I attempted to conduct a breath test with Geddes. On the second sample Geddes did not provide a continuous sample into the machine causing an invalid sample. I conducted a second mouth check at 0244 and again waited the 15 minute observation period. I conducted another attempt to obtain a breath sample, and obtained BAC readings of .201 at 0304 hours and .186 at 0306 hours.

I provided Geddes with a copy of the breath test document and Driver's Hearing request paperwork. I punched her WA license. I provided Geddes a courtesy transport to her home and advised her she would be cited through investigation with DUI.

Due to the positioning of my police vehicle at the scene of the collision, my contact with Geddes and the field sobriety tests were not recorded on my in-car camera. As no evidentiary footage was captured the tape was not removed for evidence.

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
