On 8/12/06 at approximately 0135 hours, I was stopped at a red light when I observed a blue Oldsmobile, WA CV4366 sitting at a red light two intersections south of me in lane 1 of 1 waiting to go straight for no reason the vehicle decide to run the red light and to go around the traffic in the turn lane a travel eastbound on Maryann.

I activated my emergency equipment and tried to catch up to the vehicle. I traveled east on Maryann. As I got to the intersection of Marian and 2nd Ave I observed the vehicle turn westbound on Yesler. I traveled south on 2nd Ave then westbound on Yesler. I observed the vehicle turn south on Occidental then come to a stop due to traffic. As I pulled up behind the vehicle I observed a black male wearing blue jean, and oversized white t-shirt, and a dark colored baseball hat exit the vehicle and start running south east from the vehicle. I also observed a black female exit the vehicle and walk into the crowd.

I advised WSP Communications that I was in foot pursuit and requested back up. Seattle Police arrived on scene and advised me that they are receiving phone calls from near by pay phones from a male stating that his vehicle had been stolen. I went back to the vehicle. The security guard from club Trinity which was right next to the vehicles were advised me that the female was standing near the entrance. I contacted the female and identified her as the passenger from the vehicle. I escorted her over to the patrol vehicles and asked her why they ran. The female stated, "This guy walked up to the vehicle and pulled my brother out and kidnapped me."

I searched the vehicle and found a loaded Smith and Wesson .357 revolver and a open container on the driver side floor.

I re-contacted the security guard who advised me that he could identify the driver of the vehicle. I asked the security guard if he would be willing to provide a written statement of what he observed. He stated, "Yes." At this time the security guard advised me that the driver was walking back to his vehicle. The security guard pointed the driver out.

I contacted the male and asked him why he ran. The male stated, "I didn't my car was jacked and I was down here looking for my vehicle." The male was wearing blue jeans with a white tank top. Seattle Police advised me that the security guard stated that he the male was the driver and that officers in the parking lot where the driver ran through have located the oversized white t-shirt and dark colored ball cap and that the t-shirt was still warm to the touch.


I placed the male under arrest for obstruction and read him his Constitutional Rights. I searched the driver but was unable to find any identification on him. I asked the driver what his name was. The driver was verbally identified as Griffin, Michael B, 11/22/77.

I re-contacted the female passenger who at this time was in an argument with the two Seattle Police officers and placed her under arrest for obstruction. I search the female's purse and found a WA drivers license which identified her as Griffin, Mamie C, 10/27/72.

Two Seattle Police plain clothes officer advised me that they found both the driver's and passenger's cell phone and they show that they were calling each other while we were searching form them.

I ran the vehicle's registration, revolver, and both the driver and passenger's name through WSP Communications. The return showed that the weapon and vehicle returned to Michael Griffin. The driver and passenger returned with valid drivers and no wants.

Both the driver and passenger were booked into the King County Jail for Obstruction.



STATEMENT OF DEFENDANT ON PLEA OF GUILTY

1. My true name is Michael B. Griffin.
2. My age is 29.
3. I went through the 18yrs grade of school.
4. I HAVE BEEN INFORMED AND FULLY UNDERSTAND THAT:
 - (a) I have the right to representation by a lawyer and that if I cannot afford to pay for a lawyer, one will be provided at no expense to me.
 - (b) I am charged with: Resisting Arrest
 The elements are: In King County, Washington, resist the lawful arrest by a law enforcement officer.
5. I UNDERSTAND THAT I HAVE THE FOLLOWING IMPORTANT RIGHTS, AND I GIVE THEM ALL UP BY PLEADING GUILTY:
 - (a) The right to a speedy and public trial by an impartial jury in the county where the crime is alleged to have been committed;
 - (b) The right to remain silent before and during trial, and the right to refuse to testify against myself;

- (c) The right at trial to hear and question the witnesses who testify against me;
- (d) The right at trial to testify and to have witnesses testify for me. These witnesses can be made to appear at no expense to me;
- (e) I am presumed innocent unless the charge is proven beyond a reasonable doubt or I enter a plea of guilty;
- (f) The right to appeal a finding of guilt after a trial.

6. IN CONSIDERING THE CONSEQUENCES OF MY GUILTY PLEA, I UNDERSTAND THAT:

- (a) The crime with which I am charged carries a maximum sentence of 70 days in jail and a \$ 1,000 fine.
- (b) The prosecuting authority will make the following recommendation to the judge:
90 days suspended on condition serve 1 day work crew, pay costs and assessments, no further law violations, \$200 fine.
- (c) The judge does not have to follow anyone's recommendation as to sentence. The judge can give me any sentence up to the maximum authorized by law no matter what the prosecuting authority or anyone else recommends.
- (d) The judge may place me on probation for up to five years if I am sentenced under RCW 46.61.5055 or up to two years for all other offenses and impose conditions of probation. If the court orders me to appear at a hearing regarding my compliance with probation and I fail to attend the hearing, the term of probation will be tolled until I appear before the court on the record.
- (e) The judge may require me to pay costs, fees and assessments authorized by law. The judge may also order me to make restitution to any victims who lost money or property as a result of crimes I committed. The maximum amount of restitution is double the amount of the loss of all victims or double the amount of my gain.
- (f) If I am not a citizen of the United States, a plea of guilty to an offense punishable as a crime under state law is grounds for deportation, exclusion from admission to the United States, or denial of naturalization pursuant to the laws of the United States.
