NARRATIVE

THE JUVENILE VICTIM SAID THAT HE WAS AT THE BIKE GULLY ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE RAILROAD TRACKS DIRECTLY BEHIND 215 HEATH TERRACE, TODAY. THE BIKE GULLY IS A DIRT DITCH ABOUT FIVE FEET DEEP AND TEN FEET WIDE THAT AREA KIDS USE TO JUMP THEIR BIKES OUT OF. IT IS ABOUT 25 YARDS SOUTHEAST OF THE INTERSECTION OF CORTLAND AND CENTER. THE JUVENILE VICTIM SAID THAT HE GOT IN A FIGHT WITH AN UNKNOWN KID WHO WAS ABOUT HIS AGE. HE SAID THAT THERE WERE A GROUP OF OLDER TEENAGERS AT THE GULLY. WHEN HE CAME OUT OF HIDING, HE FOUND THAT HIS BIKE HAD BEEN DAMAGED. HIS HANDLEBARS WERE BENT DOWNWARD AND HIS GEAR LEVER WAS BROKEN OFF. HIS TIRE WAS BENT OUT OF ALIGNMENT AND HIS SEAT WAS BENT INWARD. LT. PECK, WHO WAS WORKING THE COMMUNITY POLICING SATELLITE DETAIL, SAID THAT HE GOT THE NAME OF ONE OF THE OLDER KIDS WHO WERE AT THE SCENE SHORTLY AFTER THE INCIDENT. LT. PECK SAID THAT HE SPOKE TO A MARTIN T. SPENCER, 01/15/80, 15 WHITMAN, TONAWANDA, 876-7153, WHO TOLD HIM THAT THE JUVENILE VICTIM WAS RIDING HIS BIKE IN THE GULLY. MARTIN T. SPENCER ALLEGEDLY HELPED THE JUVENILE VICTIM GET HIS BIKE CHAIN BACK ON ITS SPOCKET. AT THE TIME OF THIS REPORT, I WAS UNABLE TO SPEAK TO MARTIN T. SPENCER. THE JUVENILE VICTIM ALSO GAVE ME TWO EXPLANATIONS FOR WHAT HE WAS DOING AT THE GULLY. KH
