Conditions required for a change in service:

1. **Current Level of Community Transmission drops to Substantial or below**
 - a. Rolling 7-day average of new cases per 100,000 below 100
(actual new cases less than 697)
 - b. AND % positivity below 10.0%
2. **AND CDC Forecast shows a stable or declining new case count for at least 2 weeks after the anticipated date of service change**
