Conditions required for a change in service:

**For “2. Public Service Areas Open / Modified”:**

Level of Community Transmission at **Substantial** or below

- Rolling 7-day average of new cases per 100k under 100 (actual new cases <697), and
- positivity below 10.0%, and
- CDC Forecast shows a stable or declining new case count for at least 2 weeks after the anticipated date of service change

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## **For “3. Small Programs and Activities”:**

Level of Community Transmission at **Moderate** or below

- Rolling 7-day average of new cases per 100k less than 50 (actual new cases <348), and
- positivity below 7.9%, and
- CDC Forecast shows a stable or declining new case count for at least 2 weeks after the anticipated date of service change
