


Conditions required for a change in service:

For “2. Public Service Areas Open / Modified”:

Level of Community Transmission at Substantial or below

- Rolling 7-day average of new cases per 100k under 100 (actual new cases <697), and
- Positivity below 10.0%, and

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- CDC Forecast shows a stable or declining new case count for at least 2 weeks after the anticipated date of service change

For “3. Small Programs and Activities”:

Level of Community Transmission at **Moderate** or below

- Rolling 7-day average of new cases per 100k less than 50 (actual new cases <348), and
- Positivity below 7.9%, and
- CDC Forecast shows a stable or declining new case count for at least 2 weeks after the anticipated date of service change

For “4. Full Service Operations”:

Level of Community Transmission at **Low** or below

- Rolling 7-day average of new cases per 100k less than 16 (actual new cases <69), and
- Positivity below 5.0%, and
- CDC Forecast shows a stable or declining new case count for at least 2 weeks after the anticipated date of service change
