NARRATIVE/ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Item No.

On March 15, 2011 I responded to 17408 Apartment B Lexington Ave., Hagerstown MD for a report of a suicide.

On arrival I made contact with the complainant, David Michael Malekar. Malekar stated that his wife had shot herself in the living room of their apartment. I then went to the living room which had a sheet hanging in the entrance way as a door and observed a white female in her twenties lying face up and slightly on her left side on the floor with a gunshot wound to her head. Lying next to the female was a shotgun and a Holy Bible. Female was identified as Kelly Anne Malekar, F/W/01/24/87. I asked David Malekar what happened and he stated that he was taking a nap in the bedroom that is located next to the living room and he woke up when he heard a loud bang. David Malekar stated that he then called out "Kelly" and when she did not respond he went to the living room and saw his wife lying on the floor with an apparent self inflicted gunshot wound to the head. David Malekar stated that he then called his mother at 1743 hours and when she did not answer he called the Sheriff's Department at 1745 hours. David Malekar stated that Kelly Malekar was under a doctor's care and was taking medication for a mental condition. David Malekar stated that his wife was recently released from the Meritus Medical Center where she was receiving treatment for a psychological condition. I asked David Melekar why he had a shotgun in the house and he stated he had it and two shotgun shells for home protection. I asked David Melekar if his wife had been taking her medication and he stated "yes".

Halfway Fire Department EMS supervisor James Ridgely arrived on the scene and pronounced time of death as 1759 hours. I then took photographs of the victim and the living room and took possession of the shotgun for safe keeping. CID Investigator Alton arrived on scene at 1800 hours. Forensic Investigator Blake Smyle arrived on the scene and conducted a medical examine of the victim's wound and of the crime scene and after conferral with the Medical Examiners Office and with Investigator Alton concluded the gun shot wound was self inflicted. Medical Examiners case # 112052. Medical Examiners Office released the body to Rest Haven Funeral Home. The shotgun a Savage 20 Gauge, serial # P653482 and one spent 20 gauge shell casing placed into WCSO Property under report # 10615 for safekeeping. Investigator Alton advised me that he would do the Etrace on firearm.

As per Investigator Alton case closed substantiated suicide.

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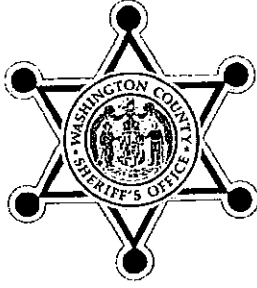

ACTION TAKEN:

On Tuesday, March 15th, 2011, I was notified of a reported suicide that had occurred at 17408B Lexington Avenue, Hagerstown, Washington County, Maryland. I was further advised that the victim was the daughter of Lt. Trav Ruppert.

I responded to the scene and made contact with DFC Jim Clay, who was the initial responding deputy. DFC Clay was photographing the scene, which was in the living room area of the apartment. A white curtain or sheet type material was hanging from the entrance way of the room. Prior to entering the room, I noticed blood and tissue spatter on the interior of the material.

Once I entered the room, I observed the body of a female lying on the floor. The female, who was identified as Kelly Ann Malekar W/F 01/24/1987, was lying on her back and slightly on her left side. I further observed a large pool of blood around her head and two large pieces of brain lying on the floor. I also noticed a large amount of blood and tissue spatter on all the walls and ceiling of the room. There was another smaller piece of brain lying on a couch that was located immediately inside the entrance way of the room. Blood and tissue was present on the couch, as well as a blanket and electronic equipment that were also on the couch.

DFC Clay informed me that he had already secured the weapon in the trunk of his cruiser. DFC Clay described the weapon as a single-shot Savage .20 gauge shotgun. DFC Clay stated that when he arrived at the residence he located the shotgun lying next to Kelly. DFC Clay stated he photographed the shotgun lying next to Kelly prior to removing it and securing it in his trunk. DFC Clay also pointed out that there was a Holy Bible lying on the floor next to Kelly.

I observed that Kelly's arms and hands were positioned in a way that was consistent as if she had been holding the shotgun. I also observed that there was a large hole in the upper rear portion of Kelly's head, which was consistent with Kelly having the barrel of the shotgun in her mouth and pulling the trigger. I noticed that Kelly's face was intact and there was no other trauma to the body other than the large hole in the upper rear portion of her head.

DFC Clay stated Kelly's husband, identified as David Malekar, told DFC Clay that he was in bed taking a nap when he was awakened by a "loud bang." David told DFC Clay that he called out his wife's name, and when she did not respond, he went to the living room and discovered his wife lying on the floor with an apparent self-inflicted gunshot wound to the head.

David informed DFC Clay that Kelly was under a doctor's care and was taking medication for a mental condition. David stated Kelly was recently hospitalized for a psychiatric evaluation.

After I finished speaking with DFC Clay, I walked to the bedroom and observed that the bed was not made and the covers were in a position as if somebody had removed the covers in a hurry to get out of bed.

I also checked the bathroom of the residence and did not observe any blood or other evidence in the sink or shower. I observed that David was wearing a t-shirt, shorts, and was barefoot. I further observed that he did not have any blood or tissue on his clothes or body that would indicate he was in the living room when the shotgun was fired.

Forensic Investigator Blake Smyle of the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner later arrived at the scene to assist with the investigation. Smyle examined and photographed Kelly's body, as well as the blood and tissue spatter in the living room. During her examination of the scene, Smyle located a live .20 gauge shotgun round that was sitting on the television stand in front of the television. Smyle documented and photographed the shotgun round.

Smyle stated all the evidence and the injuries were consistent with a self-inflicted gunshot wound. Smyle contacted the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner regarding disposition of the body. Based on the information and evidence, the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner stated no autopsy was needed and the body could be released to a funeral home of the family's choice.

While I was at the residence, I observed David cry and sob on several different occasions. David also repeatedly asked, "Why didn't she just wake me up if she was feeling depressed? I could have talked to her."

During the next several weeks, I received numerous telephone calls and e-mails from family members of Kelly. All of the family members were of the same belief that Kelly would not harm herself and that David had somehow manipulated her into committing suicide. Family members also stated they heard rumors of a suicide pact and wondered if David convinced Kelly to kill herself first and then he did not follow through with killing himself so that he could collect money from any life insurance policies.

On Tuesday, March 22nd, 2011, I conducted a follow-up interview with David Malekar and his mother, Donna Malekar. Donna had been shopping with Kelly on the day of the suicide and Donna stated Kelly did not give any indication that she was thinking about harming herself. Donna stated Kelly had been talking all day about how much she was looking forward to spring coming, planting flowers, and David and her renewing their wedding vows. Donna stated she dropped Kelly off at the residence on Lexington Avenue at approximately 3:30 PM.

After I finished speaking with Donna, I then interviewed David. According to David, Kelly never talked about hurting herself and never attempted suicide. David admitted that he was depressed recently and told Kelly that he thought about hurting himself however they talked about it and he never made any attempts of suicide. David stated Kelly was constantly afraid that "people were coming to hurt him and her or people were going to hurt Kelly's parents." David stated he always reassured Kelly that nobody was going to hurt them or her parents.

During my interview with David, I asked him where he got the shotgun and where he kept it in the residence. David stated he got the shotgun one or two years ago from a male identified as Joe Craig in exchange for David doing some computer work for Craig. David stated he kept the shotgun for protection and had shown Kelly how to use the shotgun just in case anyone tried to break in the residence while he was not home.

David stated he kept the shotgun under the couch in the living room and kept the ammunition for the shotgun in a different location. David stated he only kept two shells for the shotgun in the residence. David stated he had given the rest of the shells to his mother to keep in January or February. David stated he kept the ammunition in either the attic or in the closet in the living room. David stated he would move the ammunition from time to time. David stated he kept the ammunition separate and hidden in case small children came to the residence to visit. David stated Kelly knew where he kept the shotgun and knew where the ammunition was in the attic however he did not think she knew where he kept the ammunition in the closet. David stated he was unsure if the last time he moved the shells he moved them to the attic or the closet.

During my interview with David I also asked him about any life insurance polices. David stated that he and Kelly both had life insurance policies for each other. David stated they got the life insurance polices in 2007 through Bankers Life. David stated the policies were for \$25,000.

On Thursday, March 24th, 2011, I received an e-mail (see exhibit 1) from John Vinson, who is Kelly's uncle. The e-mail outlined the questions and concerns that family members had regarding Kelly's death. The e-mail also contained observations of David's actions and behavior after Kelly's death and at her funeral service.

Based on this investigation, there is no evidence to indicate that David Malekar had any involvement or assisted in the death of Kelly Malekar. I request this case be closed by exception.

Good afternoon Greg,

On behalf of the family, we are grateful for the work you are doing investigating the circumstances surrounding the death of our beloved Kelly Ruppert. I can't begin to imagine the stress you must go through day after day, talking with people regarding tragic and, most times, devastating circumstances. We appreciate your personal attention to this investigation.

I understand that you have met with Trav, Julie and others regarding information that may be instrumental in your investigation to help determine what may have happened that fateful day on March 15, 2011. From the time this news broke regarding Kelly's untimely and gruesome death, those close to her, and I'm talking about those who truly loved and adored her (mother, father, brother, grandparents, aunts, uncles and cousins), starting the customary "who done it" and "why" with bewilderment. It is difficult to accept that Kelly would take her own life and in such a violent manner and is incomprehensible to us all. Our concern is that other circumstances may have influenced Kelly's decision, especially since she was very fragile and in an abnormal state of mind. Please see the following link where a landmark case in Minnesota resulted in a guilty verdict for Lethal Advocacy or basically coercing people into killing themselves: <http://www.idahostatesman.com/2011/03/15/v-print/1566897/judge-ex-nurse-guilty-of-aiding.html>. Excerpt from the article: "Beaumaster said Melchert-Dinkel's intent was to see them die, and the law is designed to protect vulnerable people. "That's the point. That's who he looked for," he said. "He targeted individuals he knew he could have an influence on. Were they predisposed? Absolutely!"

Many questions and, as I am sure you have experienced in the past, many accusations and allegations flew around the room and we wanted immediate action. I've tried to capture many of the questions and points of interest that seem to be a common theme day after day as we start the healing process. We can't help but wonder was Kelly given some kind of drug rendering her helpless or incoherent or possibly an overdose of her own medication? We know the conclusion was that this was ruled a self-inflicted gunshot wound, but it doesn't conclude there wasn't foul play. Something we will never know is the exact reason why this happened but we can't help but wonder since there was no autopsy and no toxicology report. As you well know, when you don't have the answers your imagination will run away with you.

The following is a list of questions and items we would like for you to consider during your investigation and most are alleged or 3rd party unfortunately. I'm sure that much of what follows may seem repetitive based on your conversations with folks, and my intentions are not intended to imply that you haven't already looked into some of these scenarios. I just want to make sure they are at least put on the table for consideration. Feel free to call me should you have any questions or need any additional information. Thank you.

Day of shooting:

1. Where did you get the gun?
 - a. Corroborate the story with person David identifies. David's story to Trav & family at funeral home was he set up a man's computer and he gave him the shotgun.
2. Why did you have the gun in the house knowing Kelly's fragile condition?
3. Where did you get the shells?
 - a. Again, corroborate the story.
4. Why did you have only two shells in the house?
 - a. It is believed that the two shells were meant for a possible suicide pact based on previous threats of possible suicide.
5. Who gave them to you?
6. Who had the rest of the shells?
 - a. Mother admitted to having shells and David keeping 2 of them. Mother indicated that David mentioned suicide in October 2010, but she was glad he didn't go through with it. Then why would you allow him to have a gun and shells without letting someone know considering Kelly's condition? (Rhetorical)
7. Was the gun located and was it loaded? Did Kelly know the location of the gun (supposing under the couch) and who showed Kelly how to load the gun?
8. Did you previously threaten to commit suicide?
 - a. According to Julie and I believe a statement David's mom made, David had considered suicide in October 2010.
9. Did you have a suicide pact with Kelly?
10. Why do you think Kelly killed herself?
11. Why do you think she used the gun instead of a lesser violent method such as overdose?

Notes: Asking this question may get a surprise answer. If he actually knows the answer then it would be apparent they discussed the possibility.
12. Where were you when it happened?
13. Why did she wait until you went to bed?
14. What was said before you went to bed?
15. Was Kelly upset? Was there an argument?
16. What events led up to the point of you going to bed?
 - a. According to David's mom, she and Kelly went shopping earlier and Kelly brought home some soup for David. David's mom was upset because David and Kelly were supposed to order pizza and they didn't get to have it because of Kelly's death, she said with emotion "They never got to order their pizza."
17. What happened when you heard the noise?
18. What was your first call?

Notes: Confiscate phone for evidence, review phone records, review text messages, pictures, etc. At this point, it might be useful to confiscate the computer to see what pictures are present, what websites and chat rooms was David visiting frequently. This is to determine if he possibly

researched suicide planning, discussions, etc. This would show the act was premeditated if he admits to doing this. I know this sounds far fetched but it is happening every day. Strip Club Incident and Other Potential Influences/Manipulation:

1. Who took Kelly to the strip club?
 - a. When confronted in front of David, Kelly confessed to her mother that David suggested she dance for the club to make money. Allegedly, David drove her to the strip club, took her inside for introductions, he then waited in the car while Kelly auditioned as a stripper. David later denied this to Trav and said Kelly drove herself to Martinsburg.
 - b. When David was confronted by Trav regarding this, he vehemently denied this accusation and said Kelly used the GPS to find the strip club and did this on her own. However, Julie asked Kelly about using the GPS without disclosing why she was asking, Kelly said she didn't know how to use the GPS and was curious why she would even ask such a question.
 - c. Go to the strip club, talk with the manager, show him/her a picture of Kelly and corroborate the story one way or another. Apparently, other girls were present when Kelly was there and allegedly two of them performed in front of Kelly. Maybe check work records and question anyone present that day. It will give you an indication of how nervous, upset or reluctant Kelly may have been.
 - d. **If there is any truth to most of the "hearsay" it would clearly show that David could manipulate and over power Kelly in to doing things against her will, morality and personality. For instance, she didn't want to undress in front of the doctor for an exam, literally threw a fit, but she auditioned to be a nude dancer! Doesn't add up.**
2. Why did you take her to the strip club? How many times did you take her or did Kelly go to the strip club?
3. How did you convince her to do this, what did you say to her?
4. What was her reaction after she auditioned?
 - a. She confided to her mom that she was nauseated and throwing up, extremely sick on her stomach from the experience. She told her mom if she was forced to do this she would be dead in three months.
5. What was your reaction (David)?
 - a. These questions are designed to determine a motive and how he and Kelly reacted to the situation. Was there anger, grief, anxiety, illness, etc.? We have had strong indications that Kelly's increase in mental illness started Christmas Eve with the strip club incident and her actions were a cry for help.
6. Can you tell me about a situation where Kelly was taken to a Motel 6 and apparently ran away upset and ran home to her apartment?
 - a. This information was provided by a friend of David's after Kelly's death and was said to Julie. Clearly hearsay but may imply other devious

activities he was able to manipulate her into doing – potentially illegal activity.

7. Did you ever call Kelly on the phone or tell her in person that you were a terrorist such as the Uni-bomber?
 - a. Follow up questions if necessary. Again this was done to antagonize Kelly and make her believe she was crazy. This story can be corroborated by Julie (Kelly's mom). Apparently, shortly afterwards, Kelly went to the Sheriff's office and pulled the fire alarm telling everyone to get out because there was a bomb. If this happened, this is indicative of the LETHAL ADVOCACY case in Minnesota.
8. Did you ever threaten to kill Julie or tell Kelly to kill Julie?
 - a. Kelly showed up at Julie's house unannounced and told Julie that David told her to kill her. She again showed up at 3:30 in the morning on a weekday to Julie's surprise. She claimed "they" were after her and that they were going to get her and her mom. She said she called 911 and asked Julie why she was bleeding (nose bleed). You will have to confirm this with Julie and hear the rest of the story as to what took place at the hospital which was apparently a melodramatic event. A possible theory is that Kelly came to Julie's house with intentions of carrying out David's alleged wishes but couldn't go through with it and alerted her mom that something was wrong but couldn't tell her what.

Events after Kelly's Death and at the Funeral:

1. Two of Kelly's aunts visited David and his mother at their home to express condolences and to ask David to contact Trav about funeral arrangements because David was not answering or returning calls and failed to show up at the funeral home for an appointment. David failed to show any remorse or emotions, didn't shed a tear when both aunts were crying and expressing their sadness. He wouldn't make eye contact and looked down at the floor most of the encounter.
2. During the funeral services, David didn't shed one tear, in fact, he was at many times was laughing with his friends and distracting those there to mourn.
3. David's speech at the service was a performance and just short of a confession when he said that Kelly was better off today than she ever was, she is in a better place and by the grace of God he was still here and that it wasn't worse that day. Basically he was implying that he could have just as easily been victim #2. This leads us to believe that Kelly's actions were not of her own choosing or for self reasons.
4. David said that everyone at the service was there because they love "me" and didn't once acknowledge or thank people for showing their love and support for Kelly and or her family.
5. During the funeral procession to the grave site, David and his pall bearers (with the exception of Kelly's two cousins) were laughing and joking making a mockery of the occasion.
6. Many of the attendees who were not familiar with the circumstances of Kelly's death and unaware of her mental situation and marital status were shocked and bewildered by David's performance (speech) and behavior.

7. You can confirm all of this with the Priest from the Williamsport Mt. Zion church who witnessed the disturbing and disgusting behavior with eye raising and jaw dropping disapproval.

All of this may be our impression and exaggerated perspective on his behavior, but it demonstrates he is a narcissistic, pathological lying, sociopath (look up the definition and you'll find it spot on for David's personality). If you can prove criminal intent or behavior, you would be setting a landmark case for Hagerstown and may save other innocent lives that are at risk of manipulation and coercion by devious and scandalous perverts.
