1. Total number of use of force incidents reported by the Wentzville Police department, separated by year and by type of use of force, 2013-2020.

The Wentzville Police Department has categorized officer use of force into the following category descriptions:

- SEHC: Soft Empty Hand Control (restraint and control techniques without weapons)
- HEHC: Hard Empty Hand Control (hand strikes, punches, kicks)
- DIS-T: Display of a Taser
- DEP-T: Deployed a Taser
- DDF: Displayed Deadly Force
- IWD: Intermediate Weapon Display (Less Lethal bean bag, Baton, Etc.)
- IWU: Intermediate Weapon Use (Less Lethal bean bag, Baton, Etc.)
- UDF: Use of Deadly Force

The Wentzville Police Department classifies the outcome of personnel complaints with the following disposition categories:

- **Unfounded** When the investigation discloses that the alleged acts did not occur or did not involve Department personnel. Complaints that are determined to be frivolous will fall within the classification of unfounded.
- **Exonerated** When the investigation discloses that the alleged act occurred, but that the act was justified, lawful and/or proper.
- **Not sustained** When the investigation discloses that there is insufficient evidence to sustain the complaint or fully exonerate the employee.
- **Sustained** When the investigation discloses sufficient evidence to establish that the act occurred and that it constituted misconduct. Evidence in a sustained complaint will be weighed by a preponderance of the factual evidence.
