While responding to the scene I observed the suspect vehicle heading south bound on Main St with two occupants. I immediately made a U-turn and proceeded to pull the suspect vehicle over in the Walgreens parking lot at Elm St and Main St. As I approached the vehicle via the drivers side I made contact with the operator, later identified as Matthew Wezniak DOB 11-20-85, who was cooperative with my requests. The passenger, later identified as Zachary Ouellette DOB 4-6-92, however immediately became belligerent by telling me to "Fuck Off! Why are you pulling us over, you have no right, I know my rights". I attempted to explain to him that I was investigating a report of an assault at which Ouellette continued to loudly yell and swear which caused several people who were exiting the Walgreens to stop and stare at us. Off. Baidy, who is African American, then arrived and approached Ouellette from the passenger side of the vehicle. I asked Off. Baidy to try and get identification from Ouellette. As Off. Baidy asked Ouellette for identification Ouellette stated "Fuck you Nigger". Ouellette was told to step out of the vehicle because I was placing him under arrest. Ouellette initially refused and it wasn't until I removed my taser and placed the red dot on his chest that he complied. He opened the passenger side door and Off. Baidy placed him in handcuffs as he continued to make a scene and swear loudly using racial slurs towards Off. Baidy. Ouellette was causing such a scene that I had to remove him from the public parking lot and place him in the back seat of my cruiser. Prior to doing so I removed a cigarette which he had in his mouth. Ouellette continued to rock and shake the cruiser while he was seated in the back and continued to yell loudly for Off. Baidy and I to "Fuck off" and call me "Nigger lover". The driver Wezniak didn't want anything to do with the behavior of Ouellette and remarked that he was an idiot.

It was also determined that Ouellette had an active arrest warrant out of Enfield PD for Domestic Violence related charges.(See

Off. Kozaryn made contact with the victim of the assault in the area of 121 Spring St. The victim was identified as Jamey Thibodeau DOB 5-12-76. He stated that he was staying at the Enfield Inn and got punched in the face several times. He stated that he did not want to press charges and all he wanted to do was punch the other guy back.

Ouellette was transported to the WLPD and placed in the temporary holding room. Ouellette picked up a chair in the holding room and threw it at the surveillance camera. The chair impacted a ceiling vent which then fell to the floor after being ripped out of the ceiling tile by the chair. Ouellette was then placed in a regular holding cell where he then blocked the surveillance camera with a blanket and threw toilet paper all around the cell. Ouellette was then moved to the padded holding cell. Ouellette was calling Off. Baidy a "Nigger" and continued to make racial slurs towards him. While in the padded holding cell Ouellette ripped the padding from the walls which then made the padded room unusable. As a last resort Ouellette was handcuffed behind his back and his ankles were shackled. He was then transported into the holding cell next to the padded room. He was given a period of time to cool down in the cell at which time I convinced him to calm down and go through the processing procedures. Ouellette was then processed and allowed to make two phone calls.

During processing I asked Ouellette if he had any tattoos at which he lifted up his right sleeve and showed me a tattoo which stated

"White pride". When asked if he had any gang affiliation he stated "No, there aren't any good white gangs to join around here".

When Ouellette realized he was not going to make bond he was once again placed in a holding cell at the PD. Ouellette then once again used a mattress to cover the cell doors and conceal himself from the video cameras. Ouellette was then making statement that he was going to flood the toilet system. I then removed the mattress from his cell and supplied him with a small amount of toilet paper. Ouellette continued to bang on the bars very loudly and would yell "Scum bags" over and over and over again.

I contacted the witness, Bill Sampson (860-573-1595) while at the PD. He stated that he observed the victim Thibodeau walking on the roadway and that he appeared intoxicated. He stated that the suspect vehicle drove by and exchanged profanities with Thibodeau. He stated that the passenger, later identified as Ouellette, then got out of the car from the passenger side and punched Thibodeau in the head twice before getting back into the passenger seat and the vehicle heading towards Main St.

Ouellette was charged with Breach of Peace CGS 53a-181, Interfering with an Officer CGS 53a-167a, Criminal Mischief 1st Degree CGS 53a-115 and Ridicule on account of creed, religion, color, denomination, nationality or race CGS 53-37. Ouellette was held on a \$25,000 Bond with a court date set for 6-3-19 in GA-13, Enfield. I took several photographs of the damage to the cell area. These photographs were downloaded to the share drive for future use as needed.
