I've been worrying about having students (i.e. any minor) participate in any OIC sponsored program. Playing the devil's advocate, I don't think it should be allowed. A policy like: No minor will be an active participant in any OIC sponsored program that is open to an unvetted audience. I think allowing any identifiable minor (student) to speak on a controversial subject broadcast to an unvetted audience is dangerous. I think we can work around it for the same value. For instance, the group of Oakwood students regularly meeting with a group of DECA students. This is a great program to present. but I think it should be done by a faculty advisor or other adult to reports on students comments and reception but does not include the students themselves.
