Pursuant to the Pennsylvania Right to Know Act, I hereby request the following records:

With respect to any Twitter, Facebook, or Instagram account created, operated, or maintained by your agency:

1. A copy of the list of people, accounts, or pages banned by that account. This list is accessible by logging into the account as an administrator and:

(a) On Facebook, clicking "Settings" t the top of the official page, (C) clicking "People and Other Pages" in the left column, and (D) selecting "Banned People and Pages" from the drop-down menu. The final URL should look like:

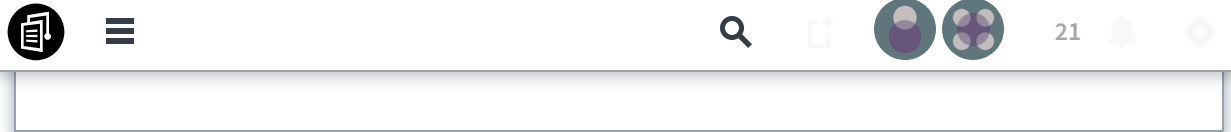
