Pursuant to the Massachusetts Public Records Law, M.G.L. c.66, §10, we hereby request the following records:

1. Documents, emails and email attachments from 2016 to through 2021 related to communications with any officers, agents, or employees of the American Border Foundation, including but not limited to: Quentin Kramer. Gary Dolan, Ryan Bosi, Jeremy Messina, Kristen Keenan, Jon Brimus, or Bill (William) Havre;
2. Documents, emails and email attachments from 2016 to through 2021 related to communications referencing a corporation with EIN 82-2806040;
3. Documents, emails and email attachments from 2016 to through 2021 with sender or recipient email addresses ending in fundthewall.com; sheriffswall.org; fairus.org; cis.org; and aviac.us;
4. Documents, emails and email attachments from 2016 to through 2021 related to crowdfunded border wall fundraising or the transmittal of border wall construction funds collected by the National Sheriff's Association (NSA) or sheriffs and deputies, regardless of membership in the NSA;
5. Documents, emails and email attachments from 2016 to through 2021 related to the transmittal of crowdfunded border wall donations to any unit of the Department of Homeland Security (the existence of this document is mentioned in a Reuters article);

We request that any fees be waived as this request is in the public interest, as suggested but not stipulated by the recommendations of the Massachusetts Supervisor of Public Records. The requested documents will be made available to the general public free of charge.

We ask that information be returned in an electronically accessible format, including for screen readers, which provide text-to-speech for persons unable to read print. Our email is bristol.county.justice@gmail.com.

Thank you in advance for your anticipated cooperation in this matter. I look forward to receiving your response to this request within 10 business days, as the statute requires.
