This is in response to your letter requesting records relating to *"all memos and publications -- both public and internal, published between January 1, 2017 and the present -- mentioning mitigation and/or adaptation plans for "heat," "increased temperatures," "climate," "climate change," or other relevant topics related to global warming"*.

Your request for any and all records pertaining to all memos and publications -- both public and internal, published between January 1, 2017 and the present -- mentioning mitigation and/or adaptation plans for "heat," "increased temperatures," "climate," "climate change," or other relevant topics related to global warming is overly broad (See: COOG Opinion FOI-AO-18863 dated 4/5/2012). This portion of your request fails to reasonably describe records as required by Public Officers Law §89(3)(a). DOCCS does not have the ability to search across all conceivable types of records by the overly broad subject matter described in your request. [See COOG Advisory Opinion f10280].

However, to the extent we were able to identify responsive records, we have 227 pages of information available. Upon receipt of your check, made payable to the **State of New York Department of Corrections and Community Supervision**, in the amount of \$56.75 covering the \$.25 per page photocopying fee, the requested document will be forwarded to you.
