The below report must be completely filled out. Checks must be made payable to "San Diego Sheriff's Department" and must accompany your request. Checks will be mailed to San Diego Sheriff's Department, Attention: Crime Analysis Unit 9621 Ridgehaven Court San Diego CA 92123. Reports will be completed in 3-5 working days after receipt of the CAU Request Form. San Diego Sheriff's Department's internal analysis demands take priority over requests received from outside entities.
