For exceptionally meritorious service in response to urgent and security-sensitive tasking directed by national command authorities from 1 November 1980 to 31 October 1982. When tasked with a unique and difficult command mission, members of SEAL Team SIX exhibited unusual motivation and intrepidity in meeting the challenge of gaining an immediate operational capability in heretofore unattempted Naval Special Warfare scenarios. The task of initially outfitting the unit and attaining this sophisticated operational capability within the timeframe directed was enormous in scope and extremely dangerous in content and required each individual to perform in exceptional fashion in order to obtain maximum operational proficiency.
