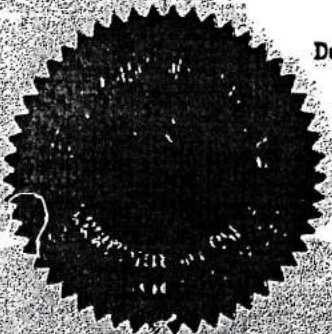

The Joint Special Operations Command and its assigned forces distinguished themselves by exceptionally meritorious service in conducting classified military operations against an armed hostile force. The Joint Special Operations Command was selected to execute this operation of extreme national importance because it possessed the unique special operations capabilities to successfully carry out the mission.
