1. INTRODUCTION:

This case originated after the February 8, 2010, receipt of information from the United States Anti-Doping Agency (USADA) about an email solicitation from PRIMORDIAL PERFORMANCE on the sale of a new product called Superdrone. The email indicates that PRIMORDIAL PERFORMANCE's Superdrone is a "Superdrol-clone" and contains the designer anabolic steroid methyldrostanolone. Superdrol (aka methyldrostanolone, aka methasteron) is a designer anabolic steroid (b) (7)(E)

Reference is made to the Report of Investigation for the period November 22, 2012 through February 11, 2013.

2. DETAILS OF INVESTIGATION:

On February 20, 2013 SCERS Agent (b) (7)(F) issued a report discussing the processing and initial review of the images made during the execution of a search warrant at the business location of PRIMORDIAL PERFORMANCE. As per Attachment C of the search warrant, an initial search of the images was required to be completed within 120 days of the execution of the search warrant, February 27, 2013. The report is included as Attachment 1.

On April 15, 2013 SA (b) (7)(F) notified Special Agent (b) (7)(F) that he would not be able to complete the search of the computer images and requested SA (b) (7)(F) apply for an extension to the search warrant. Attachment C of the search warrant required a complete search of the images be completed within 180 days of the execution of the search warrant, April 28, 2013. SA (b) (7)(F) contacted AUSA Leah Bolstad in the District of Oregon and submitted a declaration in support of an extension of the search warrant.

On April 18, 2013 SA (b) (7)(F) requested an update on the status of samples submitted to the Forensic Chemistry Center related to this investigation.

On April 26, 2013 AUSA Bolstad notified SA (b) (7)(F) that an extension order had been signed on April 22, 2013 by US Magistrate Judge Paul Papak. The extension allows for an additional 180 days to complete the search of all computer images made on October 30, 2012 during the execution of the search warrant at PRIMORDIAL PERFORMANCE.

On May 9, 2013 SA (b) (7)(F) requested an update on the status of samples submitted to the FCC related to this investigation. At the time of this report, SA (b) (7)(F) has not received a response from FCC.

During this reporting period financial analysis continued.
