1. INTRODUCTION:

This case originated after the February 8, 2010, receipt of information from the United States Anti-Doping Agency (USADA) about an email solicitation from PRIMORDIAL PERFORMANCE on the sale of a new product called Superdrone. The email indicates that PRIMORDIAL PERFORMANCE's Superdrone is a "Superdrol-clone" and contains the designer anabolic steroid methyltestosterone. Superdrol (aka methyltestosterone, aka methasteron) is a designer anabolic steroid (b) (7)(E)

Reference is made to the Report of Investigation for the period February 12, 2013 through May 10, 2013.

2. DETAILS OF INVESTIGATION:

During this reporting period Special Agent (b) (7)(F) reviewed electronically stored evidence from the computer images seized during the search warrant at PRIMORDIAL PERFORMANCE. SA (b) (7)(F) also continued with the financial analysis of PRIMORDIAL PERFORMANCE accounts.

On June 5, 2013 and July 31, 2013 SA (b) (7)(F) met with AUSA M. Parrella to discuss the investigation and proposed indictment.

On July 11, 2013 SA (b) (7)(F) requested AUSA L. Bolstad unseal the search warrant relating to PRIMORDIAL PERFORMANCE.

On July 16, 2013 the Forensic Chemistry Center provided a Case/Sample Summary Report for their analysis of items listed on CIE 185208 and seized from PRIMORDIAL PERFORMANCE during the October 2012 search warrant. The Case/Sample Summary Report is included as Attachment 1.
