Board director resigns from Vancouver Public Schools

Mark Stoker, a member of the VPS board of directors since 2007, has resigned his position, effective immediately, in response to concerns about comments he made on his personal social media account.

As reported yesterday in an article in *The*Columbian newspaper, Stoker apologized publicly for those comments. In a letter of resignation to VPS Superintendent Steve Webb, he wrote, "I have determined that to continue to serve on this board would prove too big a







I have had several people share with me today a comment made via social media by one of my fellow VPS school board directors. The comment was clearly racist in tone, if not intent. (I can't speak to another person's intent, only to the way it was received by myself and others in our community.)

...

First, I want to make it absolutely clear that Mark Stoker was speaking as an individual and his comments (via Twitter or any other platform) should in no way be construed as representing the views of the district or its Board. As a private citizen, public school educator, school board director, and human being. I unequivocally condemn his remarks and the actions they encouraged. I recognize the hurt inflicted by such words and sentiments and refuse to be associated with them, no matter how remotely. It sickened me to see his comment, and I am dumbfounded that anyone could fail to see it as anything other than racist.

Finally, I also have had people asking how will Director Stoker be held accountable? Will he be disciplined? Will he be required to make amends or apologies? There have been calls made on social media asking people to email the superintendent to somehow bring him to task. In truth, the superintendent has no authority over school board directors. It is, in fact, the other way around. The only authority Mark Stoker is accountable to is his constituency. People are, of course, free to email the superintendent or myself and the other board members. They will get a sympathetic response from those of us who were also disgusted by Director Stoker's comments. However, the only authority who can make Director Stoker accountable for his words are the voters. I encourage you to email him directly and let him know your feelings. But please also remember this in 2021: elections matter.





