If you submit your dispute resolution correspondence by email, the subject heading should clearly state "Dispute Resolution Services," and you should also cite the FOIPA Request Number assigned to your request. Your use of dispute resolution services does not toll the time limit to file a timely appeal with the Director, OIP, U.S. Department of Justice.
